I, Elijah Biggestaff, Surveyor of Denton County Texas do hereby certify that the above is a true and correct map of Sections 91 & 92 & 93 & 86. M. C. P. & P. R. R. Co. in Denton County, Texas as I find them located on the ground by actual measurement.

On the West and North of these surveys I have carefully surveyed the C. Pizano, N. Sudder, F. Davis, two A. M. Feltus, Ignatio Elds, C. Williams and C. Croward & Willis Wilson surveys; and on the East and South I have carefully surveyed the B. B. B. & C. No. 49 C. Pizano, M. Scurlock, B. B. B. & C. No. 18, J. M. Brown. Patrick Cook, F. M. Feltus & N. Emanuel surveys. I find the distance between the F. M. Feltus and J. E. Anderson surveys on the line between Sections 86 & 93, to measure 1788 varas. The S. E. corner of Sec 93, on Feltus' N. line is 616 varas East of Feltus' N. W. corner. This corner is fixed by a bearing tree. The distance between the Feltus corner and N. Wilson line is 613 varas instead of 677 varas as the Emanuel papers call for. The Emanuel survey laps on Willis Wilson 64 varas and has a living bearing tree at both N. E. & N. W. corners. The C. Croward survey extends 22 varas farther east than the Willis Wilson. The East line of the C. Croward survey is 940 varas instead of 960, as notes call for. The South, West, and North lines of the Croward survey are well marked in the timber. The Ed. Wilson survey is pointed out by

bearing true. the J.E. Anderson survey is located from the
Eldo and Tullis surveys. The distance between the Anderson
and Eldo line is 988 varas. The distance between the
S. W. corner of Anderson and West R. line of Droward
is 1082 varas. From the S.W. corner of the Anderson
survey East to the corner of Sections 99 & 86 is 1449
varas. The Sourlock survey and Anderson survey conflict
86 varas: instead of a space between them as field notes
of Sec 92 call for. This nearly closes out that portion
of Sec 91 lying between the Tullis and B.B.B. & C.R.
R. Leo survey. I have noted on this map the variation
the different surveys are run at.
