Statement of facts on the ground

State of Texas } J. E. Biggerstaff Surveyor of
Denton county } Denton county do hereby
} certify to the following facts as I
find them on the ground

The North East corner of the A. E. Orr survey is a well defined corner on the ground, the Elm tree is yet standing and found strictly correct as called for in the field notes of the Orr survey and sec 74 of the M. E. p. & J. R. K. Co; the South B. line of the Orr is well defined marked line in the timber on Hickory creek, the S. E. c. of the Orr is well fixed on the ground and of long standing, the North East corner of the Gilbert Myres survey is 100 varas East of the S. E. corner of the Orr survey, the Elm tree at the S. E. corner of the G. Myres is still standing; these facts fix these two surveys; on the East side of sec. 74 the H. J. Smith and John Scott surveys are well and undisputably fixed on the ground by noted heavy trees at the N. W. corner of Scott & S. W. corner of Smith, the actual distance between the Gilbert Myres and John Scott survey is 1829 varas instead of 1900 varas as called for in notes of sec. 74; the East B. line of A. E. Orr measures 1342 varas instead of 1318² varas; the West B. line of the G. H. Barb survey measures 384 varas instead of 385 as Barb's notes call for; the heavy trees at the S. W. corner of the Barb survey are still there, the corner is still there as set up when the Barb survey was made; from this corner going East the Barb calls to run East 1841 varas, this distance only leaves 101 varas to the West B. line of H. J. Smith; the Barb then calls to run South

1323 varas to the S. E. corner of the Moses H
Dones survey, this corner is 147 varas North of
the South B. line of Sec, 74, the Bark then calls
to run East 109 varas to the West B. line of the
John Scott survey and the N. E. corner of the
W. H. Wilburn survey; this is an error as the
N. E. corner of said Wilburn survey is over 250
varas South of this point; I find at the S. E.
corner of the M. E. P. survey 74 an old pile of rocks
but whether or not this is the original corner
of Sec 74 I cannot say or prove or disprove
but they have been carried there from the hills
as there is no rocks in the vicinity
