

ry of the League of land granted to Genl. Lockhart in the County
of De Witt and that the aforesaid 320 acre survey does join
and does not conflict with the said Lockhart from the Marks
found on the ground.

Observing that you have erased from
the Map of Toluca District the following claims that I
represent and are issuing Patents thereon to others viz
Jesus Cardenas Seven League Grant
Pedro de la Garza Eleven League Grant
Mariano de Arango Eleven League Grant
and as I understood you to say that such
erasure was made solely because they were placed on your Map
by the draftsman - and not by the District Surveyor of Toluca
I have obtained a Certified Sketch from that officer of his
Map and herewith enclose it to you in hopes that this will be suf-
ficient authority to have the same placed on the Map of that Dis-
trict and thereby stop the issuance of any further Patents - as I
conceive that the issuance of Patents on titled Lands are alike inju-
rious to the holders of the new title as well as the Old -

I would be pleased to learn if these origi-
nal titles are on file in your office and if the steps I have taken
in forwarding the Certified Copy of these portions of the Toluca
District Map will be considered sufficient to prevent further
infringement of our rights - by the issuance of Patents covered by
these Grants
