Connecting line from ~~from~~ S. W. Corner of 207. cert 525 A. B. & W. a rock mound on the south side of a large branch, the field <sup>notes</sup> call for ct. wd. 9" dia. N. 9° W. 10 1/2 ws. Do. 1" dia. N. 33° W. 29 ws. a post oak. 1" dia. brs. N. 71° E. 116 ws. I find the distance to P.O. 121 ws. the ct. wd. N. 33° W. 29 ws. has fallen down but is still on the ground and plainly marked - the other ct. wd. is gone. Beginning at this corner I thence (va. 10.30) West 2546 ws. South 1071 ws. to a stone set in the ground from which a Hby. in the bed of a branch brs. E. 43 ws. the N. E. corner # 3. cert. 334. A. B. & W. The field notes call for the line to be 43 ws. west of the corner but the tree is marked on the west side and for this reason Mr. Sam. Chalk put the corner on the west side of tree, and I make no change in the location. This unquestionably is the original corner, and makes survey 3. conflict with 229. B. S. & F. - Beginning at this corner, I thence west 698 ws. a point in west line of # 220 B. S. & F. and in the east line survey # 2. cert. 132. I. R. C. N. R. R. Co. I thence North 1184 ws. an iron pipe marked S. W. 211. B. S. & F. from which a Hby. in a branch brs. N. 31 3/4° E. 72 1/2 ws. Do. in branch brs. N. 12° W. 139 ws. (I thence West at 1900 ws. pass an iron pipe marked S. W. 1. I. R. C. N. at 3800 ws. an iron pipe the N. W. corner of # 7. and S. W. of 3. J. W. N. G. surveys. I thence North 1900 ws. to an iron pipe marked N. W. 3. T. W. N. G. I thence North



at 213 ws. to an iron pipe the S. E. corner of #4. cert of 25  
 T. W. N. C. as I correct it and in the west line of No. 2.  
 T. W. N. C. - Thence <sup>West</sup> with the South line of No. 4. 1129m

 name of J. H. Gibson, at 7600 ws. an iron pipe  
 the S. W. corner of said Gibson and N. W. corner  
 of the Saucedo survey. on the north side of  
 Little Croton creek. 95 ws. North of its north  
 bank. from which a cotton wood marked X on

North 50 ns. Do. E. 59 ns. - East Abby peak brs. S. 55 1/4 W. N.W. Abby peak brs. N. 71 W. - As there has been such a difference of opinion among surveyors as to the location of these surveys. I think a few words of explanation will not be out of place.

The field notes are signed by Geo. Spicer, but Jasper Hays did the work on the ground. When I made the final location of these surveys, I had Mr. Hays field book, and with it I finally found the S.W. corner of No. 1. cert. 97. C. E. P. I. & W. Co. which his field book shows to be a rock mark in a bend of the creek on its S. and W. bank. His book shows that he located this corner from a point on the head of Wichita, eight miles E. and one mile and 1400 ns. South. I reversed his run from S.W. of No. 1. C. E. P. I. & W. Co. with the above result, landing at the noted Abby corner at the N.E. <sup>3</sup> cert. 334. A. B. & W. - I found four of his original corners besides the Abby corner, and got 4 out of 3 of his creek calls, so I construct the Block from this base line - Oct. 20. 1902 -
