This is to certify that
as Deputy Surveyor of Young Land Dist.
in the year 1881 I resurveyed for the
Company the N + Et. N. R. R. Survey
in Block 1 Dickman County

I began at the N. West Cor. of Sec.
No. 141 Block 2 N + Et. N. R. R.
Survey in Crasby County -

Thence South and East the proper dis-
tances as represented in the original
survey to the N. West Corner of
Survey 24 Bl. 1. At this point
I found a small pile of rocks on
the East side of Duck Creek, and
N 21° W 20 rods West end of
Creek a C-wood tree 18 in diameter
on which there was a plain block
& three knots above and below. At
this point on Duck Creek there is
no regular or well defined bed or chan-
nel of the creek and the stream may
have from time to time flowed on either
side thereof. From this corner I went
up stream from corner to corner of
the survey in Block 1, and found
the stream to coincide closely with
the survey as represented by the orig-
inal surveys, except the slight variance
of the stream in passing this sur-
vey 131, 154 instead of the 155, 166

and 167, agreeing in every particular
from this point up stream for over
12 miles, and from N.W. Corner
of Sur. 24 up to this point - The
Stream being the only natural ob-
ject to fasten or govern in locating
the exact position of these surveys
strengthened by the corner found
(the N.W. of 24), and all based
upon actual survey from the N.W.
Co. of Sur. 141 Bl. 2, generally
acknowledged to be the most reliable
corner in that section, with which
these surveys are plainly connected,
it can not be possible to follow
the footsteps of the original survey-
ing authorities than as indicated
in field notes furnished after my
survey in 1881 - Having com-
menced from N.W. Corner of Sur.
141 Bl. 2 N. & Gt. N. R.R. Co. Survey
I completed a circle of over 100
miles and my route closed to within
less than 100 yards -
