Beginning at a Rock Monument, the N.W. Corner of  
Survey No. 141 Bl. 2, G. & N. R. R. Co. Surveys, in  
Crosby County, fr. wh. M<sup>o</sup>. Kenzie's Peak bears N. 74° E,  
a small cottonwood 8" at head of Ravine N. 44 1/2° W.

Thence South 1900 vs. to a large pile of rock on bank of a  
ravine. Catfish creek (White R.) 1720 E. by actual <sup>measurement.</sup>

Thence S. 45° E. 1876 vs. crossed a small branch mak-  
ing into White R. at 2688 vs. a small pile of rock. White  
R. 1/4 mile E.

Thence S. 77° vs., M<sup>o</sup>. Kenzie's trail, at 1900 vs. the S.E.  
cor. Sur. 135, at this point Catfish cr. about 1/2 mile E.  
a pile of rk for cor. f.w. S. <sup>Pt.</sup> point of plains bears S. 40 1/2° E.  
M<sup>o</sup>. Kenzie's Pk. S. 40 1/2° E. the E. end M<sup>o</sup>. Kenzie Mt. br S.  
13 1/2° E.

Thence S. 45° E. at 1815 vs. M<sup>o</sup>. Kenzie's trail at 2688 vs the  
S.E. cor. Sur. 131 a large pile of rk f.w. a point of the plains  
br. S. 22 3/4° E. At this cor. White R. 1/3 E. about, and Evans  
Cr. 1/4 m. about W.

Thence S. 45° E. 2688 vs. the S.E. cor. of Sur. 135, a st. and pile  
of rk f.w. a C. wood 10' x br. S. 5° N. 11 1/2 vs. At this cor. White R.  
100 vs. E. and 380 vs. S. about. Evans Cr. 1/4 mile about  
W.

Thence S. 1900 vs. a rk monument 3 ft. dia 3 ft high,  
f.w. a lone tree in Shinery Cr. S. 49 1/2° E. about 1/2 m.  
White R. 1/4 mile E. and Evans Cr. 2/3 m. W. about.

Thence S. at 1650 vs. road at 1900 vs. the N.W. cor.  
Sur. 111 a pile of rock near old trail (the pile of rock  
contains a section of petrified tree 1 ft dia 2 ft long  
White R. 1/3 m. E. and Evans Cr. 3/4 m. W.

Thence S. 45° N. at 1740 vs. Evans Cr.; at 2170 vs.

branch of White R. at 2688 vs. the S. W. cor. sur. 110 a pile of rock in side of ravine near plum thicket f.w. lone tree brs. S.  $77\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  E. Catfish Cr. White Rabbit  $\frac{1}{2}$  m. E.

Thence S. at 2600 vs. a sulphur spr. about 40 vs. E of line at 1900 vs. the S. W. cor. sur. 101 a pile of rock f.w. the S. end of a prominent Pt. of the plains brs. N.  $86\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  W. a large rock on S. side Home Cr. at foot of bluffs brs. S.  $83\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  E. White R.  $\frac{7}{8}$  miles about E.

Thence S. at 720 Home Cr.; at 1900 vs. the S. W. cor. sur. 98 and S. W. cor. sur. 89 a pile of rocks f.w. a Cwood on S. side of Slaughter's Cr. brs. S.  $25\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  E. about  $\frac{1}{2}$  m. a small hackberry S.  $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. about same distance. White R.  $\frac{4}{5}$  m. about E.

Thence S.  $45^{\circ}$  E. at 924 vs. crossing Slaughter's Cr. at 2688 vs. the S. E. cor. 89 a large pile of rock (on old pile supposed to be of original surveyors). White R.  $\frac{2}{3}$  m. E. and  $\frac{1}{3}$  m. N.

Thence S.  $45^{\circ}$  E. crossing Catfish Cr. at 1460 vs. and 2580 vs.; at 2688 vs. the S. E. cor. sur. 85 a pile of very large rock, f.w. a Cwood  $6' \times$  brs  $81\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. 63 vs. and a do.  $4' \times$  brs S.  $80\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  E. 50 vs. - Monument on top of hill (not visible at this point) but not over 100 m. S. E. road crossing near.

+ Thence S. 1900 vs. the S. E. cor. of sur. 74 a large pile of rock. the R.  $\frac{1}{2}$  m. E.

Thence S. 1900 vs. the S. E. cor. sur. 70 a pile of rock & buffalo bones. White R. about 500 vs. E.

Thence S. at 180 vs. White R.; at 820 vs. recross the saw; at 1900 vs the S. E. cor. sur 59 a large pile of very large rocks. White R.  $\frac{1}{2}$  m. E. about.

Thence S.  $45^{\circ}$  East crossing White R. at 1800 vrs, and  
at 2380 vrs.; at 2688 vrs. the S.E. cor. of Sur. 55, a C'wood, st.  
in sandhill f.w. a C'wood  $10' \frac{1}{8}$  brs. N.  $46 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. 192 vrs., and  
 $11' \frac{1}{8}$  brs. N.  $49 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. 237 vrs., and  $11' \frac{1}{8}$  brs. N.  $59^{\circ}$  E. 200 vrs  
(this cor. near a picket dug out on bank of White R. wh.  
is 300 m. E. about.)

Thence S. at 1900 vrs a large pile of rocks near rocky  
bluffs, this the S.E. cor. Sur 42, White R.  $\frac{1}{3}$  m. E,  
about-

Thence S. at 1900 vrs a pile of rocks on side  
of a mound the N. W. cor. Sur 24. E. end  
Kyle's cattle pen brs.  $35 \frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  N, White R  
E.  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile about.

Thence S.  $45^{\circ}$  E. 2688 vrs to a pile of rock  
the S.E. cor. Sur. 41, White R. N. about  $\frac{1}{4}$  m  
W. E. about 700 vrs.

Thence S. crossing Dan Kyle's Cr <sup>1900<sup>20</sup></sup> W.  
cor. Sur 19, a pile of rock near Buffalo mound.

Thence E. 1900 vrs to S.E. cor. Sur 19 large  
pile of rock - Hunted faithfully on two  
separate occasions for mummified +  
nothing found.

Thence E. from S.E. cor. Sur 19 at 1740  
vrs cross White R. at 1700 vrs to N.E. cor.  
Sur 5 a stake & pile of rocks, North end  
of Buffalo Md. bears abt.  $83 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  N. - S. end of Buffalo  
Md. brs. N.  $85 \frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  N.

Thence E. 1900 vrs. to the S.E. cor. sur. 4. a pile of  
rock from w. the S. end of Buffalo md. brs. N.  $86 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$   
N.

Thence E. 1900 vrs. to the S.E. cor. Sur. N. 3a st. f.  
w. Cooper Mt. brs. S.  $16 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. - E. end Mt. Kenzie. Mt. brs

S.  $4\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  N.

Thence S. 1900 vs. to a st. f.w. a sharp peak on N. side of Catfish cr. brs. S.  $56^{\circ}$  N., about 1 mile

Thence E. 1900 vs. to a st. in open prairie f.w. Mt Cooper brs. S.  $14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E.; a mesq. 12'  $\times$  brs. N.  $33\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  N. 69 vs. S.E. cor. Sur. 2.

Thence E. 1900 vs. (+  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ) the S.E. cor. sur. 1. an E. mid and 4 pits.

Began at S. N. cor. sur. 19. soon 2, a pile of rock near Buffalo Md.

Thence S. at 1505 vs. M<sup>o</sup>. Kenzie's trail; at 1900 vs. the S. N. cor. sur. N<sup>o</sup> 6 an E. mound & 4 pits in swag.

Thence S. thro' shiner, the last  $\frac{2}{3}$  mile to S. N. cor. sur 13 an E. mound & 4 pits.

Thence S. thro' shiner, 1900 vs. the S. N. cor.; S. N. cor. sur. 20. a sand mound and 4 pits on edge of shiner, a sharp point of rock brs. S.  $38\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  N.

Thence S. at 1840 vs., Salt Fork; at 1900 vs. an E. mound & 4 pits on banks in plum thicket.

Thence E. 1900 vs. to S.E. cor. sur. 37 an E. mound & 4 pits f.w. Sharp Pt. Rocks brs. N.  $80\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  N. Salt Fork only 100 vs N. of cor.

Beginning at S.E. cor sur 1, Blk 2, being the S. N. cor of 13, blk 1; thence E. at 800 vs cross Salt Fork of Brazos, 1900 vs to st in bed of Salt Fork Cottonwood 10 in  $\times$  S.  $25\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  N 11 in, ditto 8 in  $\times$  S.  $64\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  N 18, Salt Fork edge of River about 100 vs E } Thence N. 100 vs cross Salt Fork 1160 again, 1600 vs third time, the line passing 40 vs E of mouth

of Big Red mud CK 1900 vs to N.E. Cor  
Sur 13. Side of rock fr. one of 4 small  
chuna trees brs S  $8\frac{1}{2}$  E 100 vs. Thence E.  
1900 vs S.E. cor Sur 35 fr wild chuna 3 ins  
brs S 21 E 51 vs Hackberry 4<sup>in</sup> S  $82\frac{1}{2}$  E  
25 vs mouth of little Red Mud CK  
S 70 N 200 vs. Thence E. crossing little  
Red Mud CK at 60 vs, 1900 vs N.E.  
cor Sur 15, pile rock fr cedar 6<sup>ins</sup>  
brs N 13 E 77 vs ditto 8<sup>ins</sup> N  $3\frac{1}{4}$  E 61 vs  
both trees in a ravine. Thence S 1900 vs to  
pile rock for SW cor No 16. Thence S.  
crossing Salt Fork at 400 vs 1900 vs  
to SW cor Sur 9 Thence E 1900 vs to P.E.  
cor Sur 9 fr cottonwood 10 in.  
N. 16 N 20 vs. Thence E crossing Salt Fork  
at 200 vs 1900 vs to rock mid S.E. cor  
Sur 8 Thence E. 1900 vs to pile 'Buffalo  
Bone' S.E. cor Sur 7. Thence E. 6 miles  
to a point about 600 vs E of Duck CK.  
Here I abandoned my survey & hunted  
for signs & marks in the valley of Duck CK  
Finally found a Cottonwood plainly  
marked with marks & blaze fr  
an old pile of rock brs S 31 E. 30 vs.  
Had identified both tree & mound as those  
mentioned in the field notes of Sur  
24 as its N. N. cor. Thence S. 1 mile  
E 1 mile & South 1 mile connected  
with my point - about 600 vs E of Duck  
CK & established the P.E. cor of Sur 1  
BK 1. < The running from N.E. cor 37

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BLK 2 E to the N. W. cor of 24 BLK 1 as  
 found on the ground shows a surplus  
 in measurement between said two points  
 which being inconsiderable was distributed  
 between the different corners. Beginning  
 at N. W. cor of 24 BLK 1 thence N  
 at 6700, at 9230, at 16690, cross and  
 new of Duck Creek, at 18300 Marblebank  
 Creek line passed about 1100 west of  
 mouth of Marblebank Creek at 19000  
 established pile of rocks for a cottonwood  
 24 in.  $\bar{x}$  at 39th 2000 Hackberry  
 4 in.  $\bar{x}$  at 66 1/2 N 1000 Marblebank  
 Creek 1700 N of cor of the Cottonwood  
 24 in. had plainly marked cross and  
 marks on it & tho' not called for in  
 original field notes is supposed  
 to have been made by the original  
 surveyor & omitted from the field  
 notes.

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
