I wrote you some time since in regard to the Excess between the N.E. Cor of Sur No 141. and 148. B S + F and west of same, to the E line of Dickens Co. and since writing you I have made another survey, but have not completed it but find that the Excess begins at the N E Cor of the Thos Mattison Survey and is Excessive all the way to the N.E. Cor of Sur No 148. B S + F. and Extends west to the E line of Dickens Co. and I find that the Field Notes in my office does not call for any bearings from the N E Cor of the Thos Mattison sur to N E Cor 148 B S + F. These two corners are well defined on the ground the latter being a Buffalo head which is gone but both bearings are still standing and the Thos Mattison a stone with two Bearings are still standing now what I wish to know is can I begin at either one of these old corners and give each survey its proper compliment and make a vacancy at the opposite side which will make something near 640 acres of un surveyed school Land for the state. The distance between these two points would be about 9 3/4 miles North and South and about 5 miles west very near all of these surveys have been Patented to their course and distance will advise you fully very soon. Please answer at once

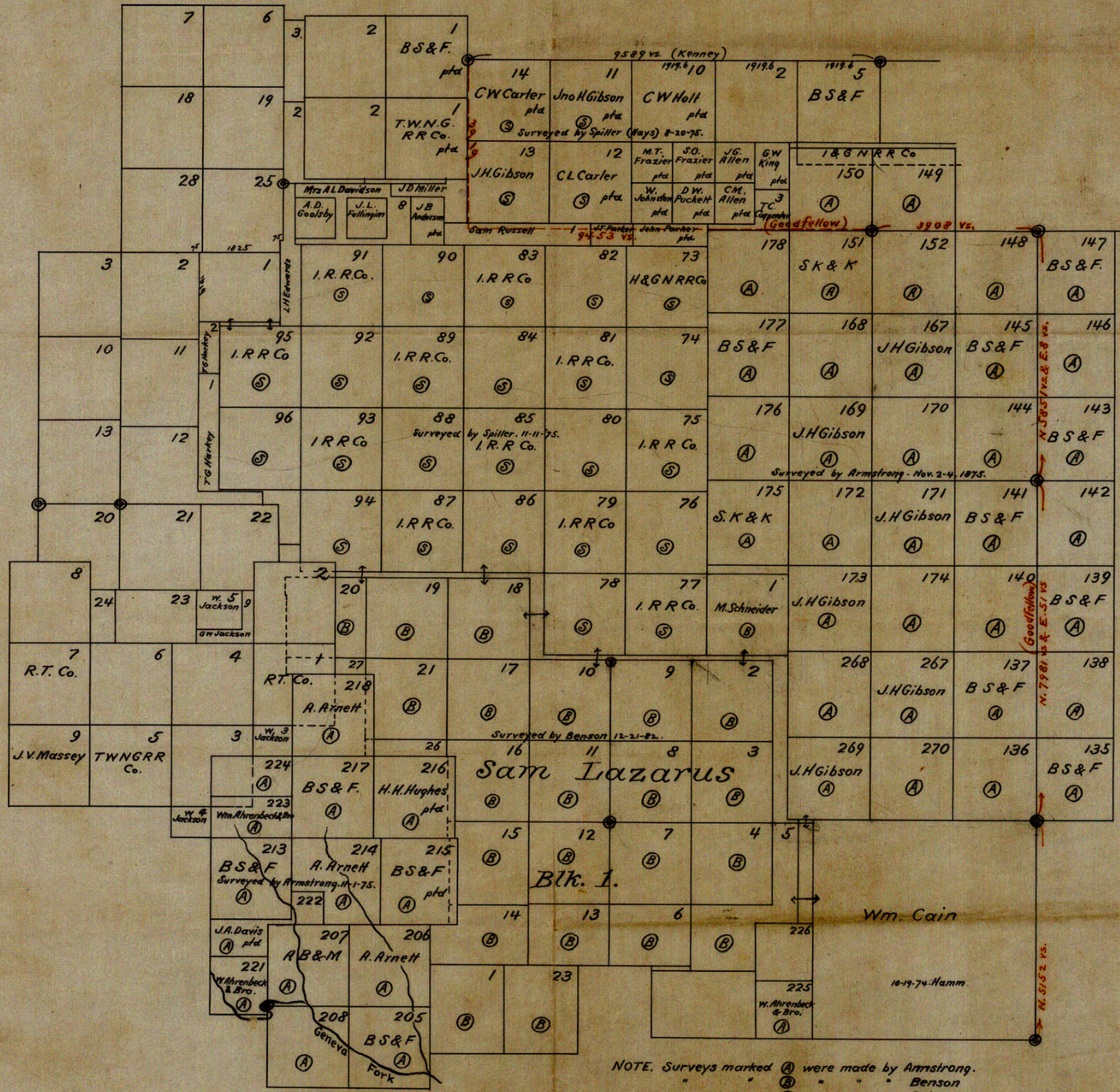
