

Explanation in connection with  
my resurvey of the B.D. Glasgow,  
Survey No. 1 Block X, Dickens County  
Tex. — The Ell or inner corner of  
the Saml. L. Burns Survey which is the  
N.E. corner of the B.D. Glasgow survey  
is located or placed by a course  
and distance run from the S.E. corner  
of the M. Oliveres survey. The said S.E. corner  
of the Oliveres is 207 or. East and 412  
or. South of an iron pipe in deep cañon  
set by R.M. Kenney. I made a careful  
check run from Kenney's pipe to S.E. corner  
of Oliveres & found it. Also checked 2176  
or. S & 372 W. to Ell or inner corner of  
said Burns sur. and <sup>said</sup> corner as set by J.D.  
Harkey Co. Surveyor in March. 9 / 1923 I  
found to be correct. The Matador fence called  
for for S. Line of the Glasgow sur. was built  
in fall of 1860 and was put on a line  
run by J.D. Harkey from old gyp. mound  
at original N.E. corner of sur 31. This fence  
is not too far North and I adopted it as the  
N. Line of 31. The Keifoin work on Block A.S.  
requires a greater variation than I find this  
fence for East. course. The West Line of the  
Glasgow. I stopped at fence set on E. Line of No.  
2 M.C. R.R. Co. as fixed by decree of Court  
in the Kennedy vs. Ballard suit. The  
courses used by me in this survey are based  
on South Line of the Oliveres Survey, calling  
it East & West. or in 11-21 E
