At request of A.T. Bass, of Dumont Texas, I made the following survey. Beginning at an Iron pipe at the SW Cor No. 2 H. & G. N. Blk. G. Dickens Co, as recognized by R.M. Kenney State Surveyor, from which mes' brs E 574 vrs Mrkd X on W side. Thence E 2373 vrs and N 96 vrs for SW Cor Survey No. I TWNG cert o/4I, at this point I found no CW in ravine 180 vrs W, but it placed me in open prairie where no CW ever grown. Thence E 1427 vrs from this point and N 4700 vrs I find CW 30' brs west 180 vrs mrkd X on E side (old). Can this be sufficient to place No. I TWNG cert o/4I SW corner at this place. I inclose you pencil sketch showing my run. Can any vacancy exist between Surveys No. I TWNG cert o/4I Sur No. 4 BS&F and Surveys Nos. 13, 14, 15 and 16 J.H. Gibson.
