I, J. T. Robison, Commissioner of the General Land Office of the State of Texas, having been requested by letter dated February 16th, 1921 and signed Chas. McLaughlin, County Judge of Dickens County, Texas, to designate by certificate the geographical center of Dickens County, do hereby certify that I have from the map of Dickens county and other data on file in this office ascertained the geographical center of said county; that upon the official map of said Dickens County now in use in this office, the geographical center thus determined is a point within the limits of the Elizabeth Herring, alias Watson, survey, of one league and labor of land patented February 20th, 1880 by patent No. 188, volume 23, 2730 varas South 55½ West from the North East corner of said Herring league and labor survey.
