Under your appointment as Special Surveyor dated Austin March 24.th 1877, I made the following connection as requested by your office:

Beginning at the stone mound on top of a conical hill, called the Pelloneros, this being the North corner of the Joaquin Palau Grant thence North at 4780^{ms} crossed a branch, course SE. to NW. at 9480^{ms} crossed other branch, course East to West, at 10260^{ms} other branch, course the same, at 11,400^{ms} other branch, all going into Rivers Creek, at 15490^{ms} crossed branch, course SE to N.W., going into the San Roque Creek, at 17,300^{ms} crossed San Roque Creek, at 17,328^{ms} crossed road from Carizo to Cochina, at 17698^{ms} point, thence East 636^{ms} to large Hackberry trees on the beginning of the Laguna San Roque, which are 950^{ms} ^{South} from North corner of Survey No 9 Tex. & N. O. R. R. Company.

The Almod could not be seen from the Pelloneros and weather too cloudy to have a sight to the Dos Hermanos, but will make proper connection in short time to the later named hills.
