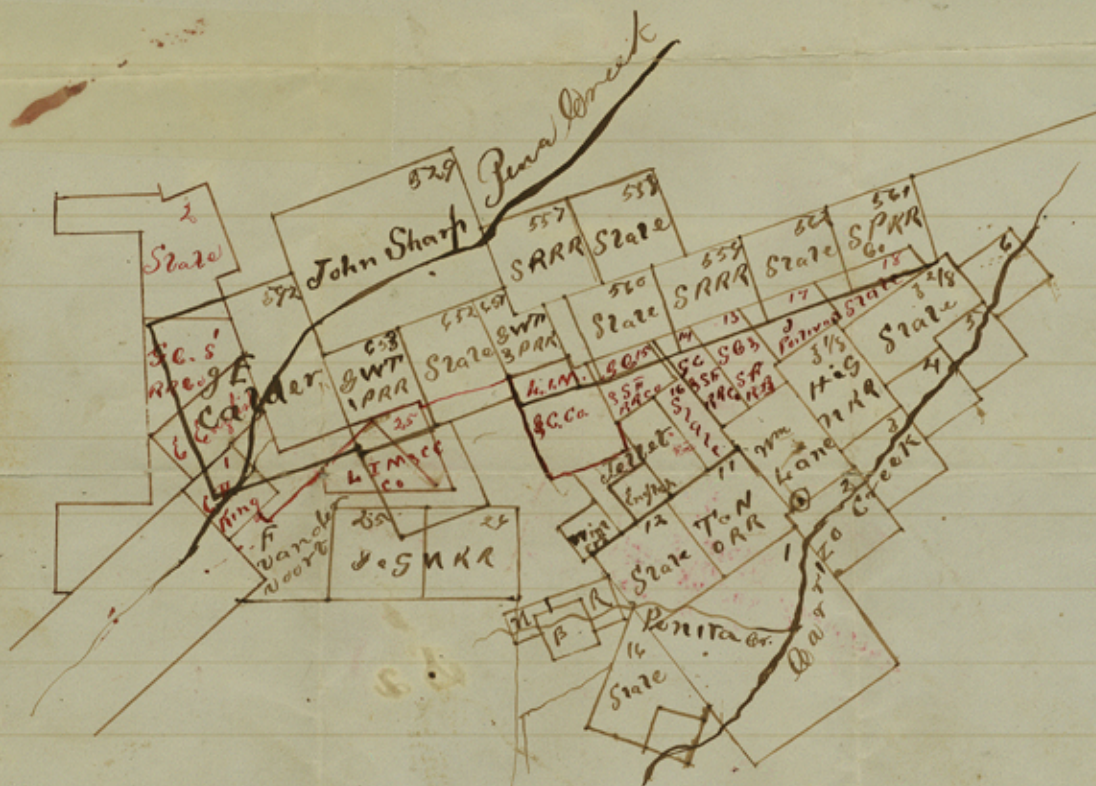

as called for by field notes of King survey  
and run the line marked in red ink  
on sketch. run according to field notes of  
of the P.W. Hughes J.E. Calder no 592  
G.W.P. & P. no 958 State 652 & A.D. M. S. S. S.  
and connected as called for at the N.W.  
corner of what was then the Philip

presumption survey and by a later survey  
a part of the Jellet survey

Began at the N.W. corner of S.P.R.R. Sec  
557 and found bearings as called for  
on N side of Peña creek. run S 20 E 2120  
varas and found stakes in old Presidio  
road from which a new marked ~~the~~ old marks  
br N 14° E 35 varas and ~~was~~ instead of N 14 E 27  
another N 75 E 140 instead of S 70 W 112  
Run Thence N 70 E 144. Thence S 20 E 1500  
Thence N 70 E 860 Thence N 20 W 60

which as you will see is equivalent to  
running N 70 E 1004 and S 20 E 1440 and  
which the corner of the S. I. M. & C. Co.  
supposed to be on the S line of the Sec  
651 G. W. S. P. R. R. 2075 S 20 W from the SW corner  
of said S. I. M. & C. Co.
