Hors N L McGaughey - Dear Sir

Yours of the 3rd inst has been rec^d and noted, in reply will state that I have no data in this office to enable you to obtain connections between the Mr Law Stewart Newell June & Calder & Co

These connecting lines will require actual work upon the ground and considerable expense, which I am not very well able to incur, The country through which the lines will run is very rough, and ~~it~~ ^{the work} will necessarily progress slowly, I think a reasonable compensation should be provided, and if that is done, I will promptly do the work,

As to the connection between the Mr Law and Blas Reys Grant another difficulty presents itself, I have what purports to be the field notes of the Grant

made by Deputy Surveyor A. L. Hector in May 1880 the corners and lines made by him can be found, then Dr Taylor (as I learn) had the Grant surveyed by Surveyor J. A. Barnes for the purpose of fencing, Mr Barnes made the corner of the Grant some two or three hundred yards from the corner made by Hector, then recently the Surveyors appointed by the order of Court in a suit pending on the Francisco Puryrie Grant; established the corner of Blas Reyes Grant several hundred yards from either of the corners referred to above, I should be at a loss to know which of these corners to recognize, I can find and connect with either of them, I am of the opinion the Blas Reyes was not ^{surveyed} ~~made~~ on ground, until done by Mr Hector, at least I have no evidence of it, If this work is to be done by me, would be glad to be instructed
