FIELD NOTES OF A SURVEY of that portion of the JUAN FRANCISCO LOMBRANO GRANT lying in Dimmit County and made by order of the County Commissioners Court thereof.

Said survey is No. 16 in Dimmit County Texas situated on the waters of San Ambrosia creek a tributary of Rio Grande river about 25 miles southwesterly of Carrizo Springs.

Beginning at south corner of the Rivas Grant on the Rio Grande river identified by a marked mesquit very similar to the one called for in the field notes of said Rivas Grant; rock mound and chepota therein called for not found, position of same caved off the bluff.

Thence N 18 1/2 E along fence said to be on the Rivas east line 5414 varas to S W corner of Lombrano Grant I find to be a known and acknowledged corner.

Thence N 84 E at 5240 varas the dimmit County W boundary line 210 varas S of the 29th mile post; on same course at 5940 varas San Ambrosia creek near the mouth of San Pablo creek formerly called San Pedro creek; on same course at 10340 varas a gate on Chupedro and San Pedro road near the Cathedral rock; and on the same course at 14839 varas the S E corner of this Grant.

Thence N18 1/2 W at 25800 varas the N E corner of pasture at 26578 varas the N E corner of this Grant.

Thence S 81 1/2 W 779 varas to a stake on the E boundary line of said Rivas Grant.

Thence S 9 1/2 W 700 varas the N W corner of said pasture; on same course at 2590 varas Glass' fence on said Rivas Grant and on same course at 7100 varas the West boundary line of Dimmit County 284 varas S of the 19 mile post.

Thence South 2 1/2 E with the West boundary line of Dimmit County

19074 varas to the South line of this Grant.

In making the foregoing survey I followed the decree of the District Court of Dimmit County establishing the boundary lines of said Lombano Grant, entered in a suit wherein the New York and Texas Land Co. Limited was plaintiff and Mrs. Mary J. Votaw was defendant. The aforesaid boundary lines of this Grant as far as I ran the same having been fenced for a long time, a new fence now standing having replaced an old one, save that a small portion about 700 varas in width off the North end has never been included within said fenced boundaries.
