Dear Sir:-

Your favor of the 24th Ult. was duly received together with the field notes of a connecting line and sketch of lands on the line of LaSalle and Dimmitt counties also application for a survey under the Act of April 15th, 1905, by D. W. Light for supposed vacant unsurveyed school land. In reply would say ~~the~~ only vacancy that I find is the small strip as indicated in green on the enclosed blue print sketch south of No. 115 and between sections 136 & 4.

The small strip in yellow is a part of the J. G. Brawly 160 acre pre-emption (Bexar P. 6215), the balance of said pre-emption being in conflict with senior patented survey No. 1, G. C. & S. F. Ry Co and school section No. 132-sold to Wm. Clary. There is on file a proof of three years occupancy of the Brawly pre-emption. Is it a fact that Brawly actually lived out his three years as sworn too in the proof? If not, in that event the space in yellow would be subject to file under ~~Act~~ April 15th, 1905.

You have indicated on your sketch in broken or dotted lines sections, 1, 2 and 3, G. C. & S. F. Ry Co Scrip. 4647 & 4648 as being junior to sections 1 & 2 T C R R Co cert. No. 1756. This is an error. The G. C. & S. F. Ry. Co. surveys are senior, they were patented at least two years prior to the survey of 1 and 2-T. C. Ry. Co. hence the G C & S F Ry. Co. surveys are held superior by this office and will hold over section 1 and 2 T C R Co.

School section No. 2, cert. 4647 G C & S F Ry Co has been sold to W. F. Jay containing 640 acres.

There is a small strip of No. 2 T C R Y Co not in conflict, say 246*2637 1/2 vrs about 115 acres that could be placed on the market as surveyed school land.

I am returning you the application for survey of D. W. Light.

The sketch and field notes of connecting line I have filed in Dimmitt county sketch files.

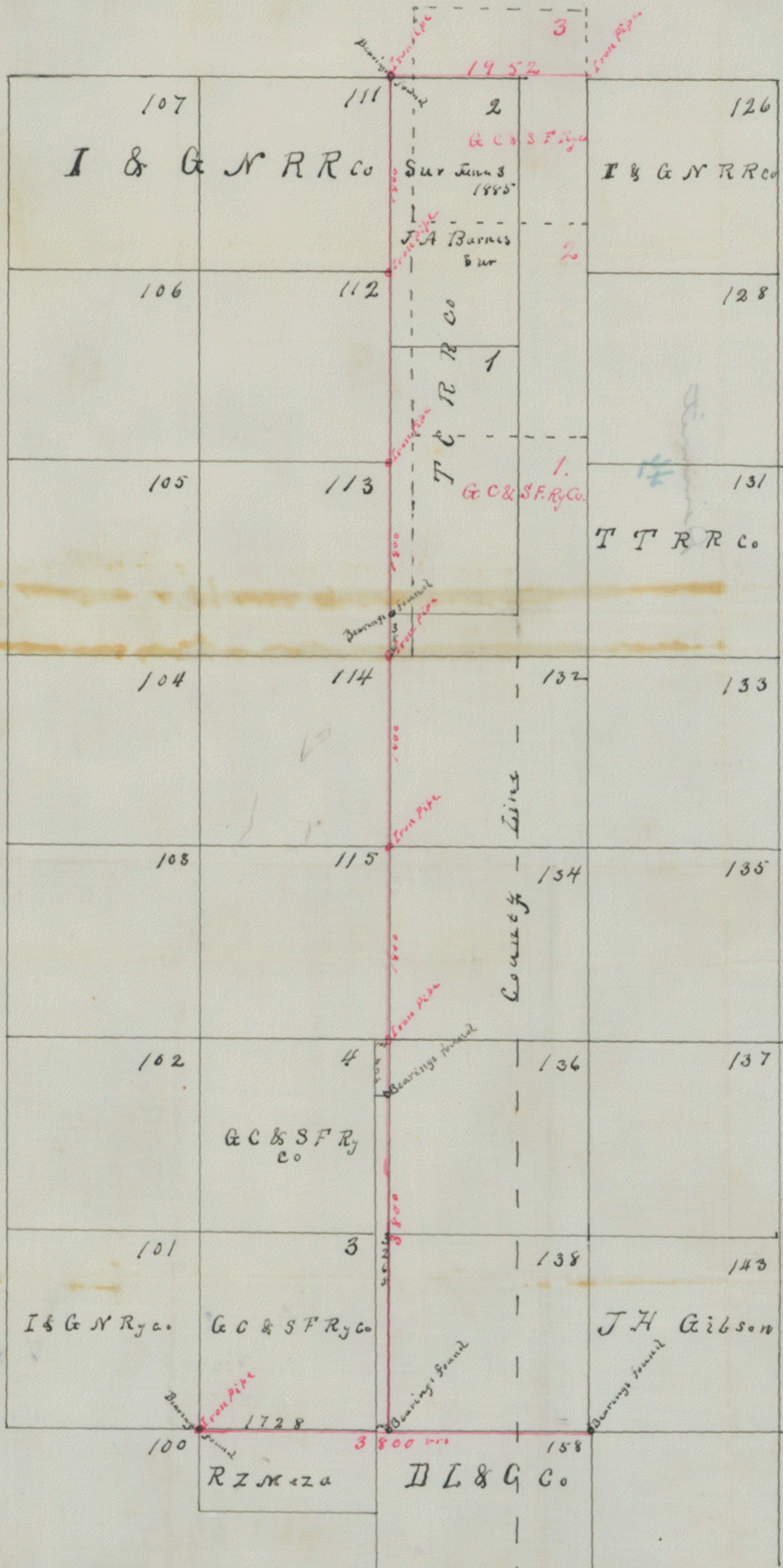
