Parks Deputy Surveyor of Jack Land District do hereby certify that the NE corner of survey No 11 Block C & by sub d of D & P RR cert No 3 is a stake and buffalo head about 300 varas east of head of draw from which three cottonwoods in clump of 8 in slow wind cracks S 65 1/4 E 880 varas. At these trees are marked X. and the SE corner of said survey is a stone in an earth mound on high bluff on hill on edge of break at little cottonwood from which a rock point bis N 85 W 75 varas and line quarry to N 32 1/4 W a line to N 66 1/4 W about 1/2 mile and the S.W. corner of survey No 5 & N.W. of No 28 same block. The S.W. cor of survey No 11 the N.E. of No. 12. is a point in the middle of the sand bed of Saddlers creek from which a stone in a mound in sand of earth on sandhill bis West 70 varas.
