

Connecting Lines in Tonley County.

Beginning at the SW corner of survey N^o 4 Franklin County Schoolland a cedar post in large Earth Md. from wh. an iron pipe in centre of old earth mound at corner of fence, the SE cor of Survey #71 Block B3 H & G N, R R Co. - br: North 500 vas.

Thence N 89° 50' E - Variation 11° 40' E - 5000 vas. to an iron pipe 3' x 1 1/4" set beside old iron sta in old rock md. the SE cor. of said sur #4 & SW corner of sur #3.

Thence S 0° 10' E 1900 to a point. Thence S 89° 50' W 1494.7 to an iron pipe 3' x 1 1/4" mtd. ^{NO} NW 17 in rock md from wh. another rock md set by me for bearing br: N 34° 5' E 90.8 vas.

Thence South 1014.6 vas & West 1344 vas. to an old rock md the SW corner of sur #5 Block G 4.
