Dear Sir: I hereby submit to you my report of a survey made for Mrs J.G.Lowe, of Section No.72,74,76 A.B.&.M., Section No.414 A.B.&. M., and Section No.465 B.S.&.F. all in Duval County, Texas.

I began work at the South West corner of section No.76,A.B.&.M. Northwest corner of Section No.413 A.B.&.M,the Southeast corner of section No.1,H.&.G.N.R.R.Co. and the Northeast corner of section No. 2,A.L.Labe, where I found an old pointed mesquite post from which a mesquite tree marked Y bears North 12-30' East 1 varas also I found at this point a concrete post 5/10 vara east of the post.

Then I ran a line North and at 301 and 306 varas passed two mesqt. trees marked ⁼ and at 1929.6 varas I found a pointed mesquite post from which a mesquite tree marked R bears South 64 - 00' East 9 varas. the original Northwest corner of section No.76, the Southwest corner of section No.75, A.B.&.M. the South East corner of section No.104 B.S.&.F. and the Northeast corner of section No.1, H.&.G.N.R.R.Co.

I then ran East along an old marked line but did not find any corners until at 5494.5 varas I found a pointed mesquite post the original Northeast corner of section No.72, the Northwest corner of section No.70, the Southeast corner of section No.71 and the South west corner of section No.69 all A.B.&.M. from said post I found the original mesquite #### tree marked 0 that bears North 78-00'West 52 varas.

I then returned to the comon co rner of sections No.76,413,1 & 2 the beginning point of my work and ran a line East and at 1923.5 varas set a pointed mesquite post from which found the original mesquite tree marked X that bears South 47-30'West 4 varas, the original witness tree to the Southeast corner of section No.76, the Southwest corner of section No.74 and the Northeast corner of section No.413 the Northwest corner of section No.414 all A.B.&.M. continuing East along an old marked line at around 3850 varas I looked for the North

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East corner of section No.414, the Southeast corner of section No.74, the Northwest corner of section No.465 and the Southwest corner of section No.72, but failed to find any evidence of any old corner except the corner of an old fence line, this point was on top of a farely open hill with very little old timber, coutinuing East with an old merked line at 5777.5 varas I found an old pointed mesquite post marked V the original Northeast corner section No.465 and Northwest corner of 466 B.S.&.F., the Southeast corner of section No.72, and the Southwest corner of section No.70 both A.B.&.M. from which post I found the original mesquite tree marked V that bears South 73-00'East 46 varas.

I then ran a line along an old fence South 00-48' East and at 1921 varas to a point in fence which is East 117 varas from an old pointed post the original Northeast corner of section No.467,H.&.G.N. and the Northwest corner of section No.204,J.Poitevent.

Thence West from point in fence at 117 varas passed said pointed mesquite post and at 1935.2 found an old pointed mesquite post marked 5,the Southwset corner of section No. 465 B.S.&.F. and the Southeast corner of section No.414,A.B.&.M. continuing West at 2410 varas passed an old pointed mesquite post marked E.G.the Northwest corner of section No.467 and the Northeast corner of section No.468 both H.&.G.N. and from said post I found an old mesquite tree marked = that bears North 36-00' West 21 varas., and continuing west at 4228.1 varas I found an old pointed mesquite post marked G (post now rotted down and a concrete post placed in place with a mound of sand rock.) the North west corner of section No.468, the Northeast corner of section No.415. I then measured from said pointed post marked G East 348 varas

but could not find any evidence of the Southeast corner of section No.413 and the Southwest corner of section No.414 so placed an iron 2 inch pipe for said corner from which I marked a mesquite tree E that bears South 20-00'East 56.7 varas another mesquite tree marked E bears South 59-00' East 15.3 varas. and here quit work of the

survey.
