EXPLANATION TO ACCOMPANY CORRECTED FIELD NOTES OF
BS&F SURVEY 526, LAND SCRIP NO. 1643, DUVAL COUNTY,
TEXAS.

Beginning at the SE Corner of Survey 526 which is a very old Mesquite stake mkd. V. a sendero was first run North with a Variation of $9^{\circ} 30'$ East, 1900.0 vs. No trace of the Original corner or Bearing trees were found after a search of one entire day for 100.0 vs. in all directions in a very heavy Mesquite thicket. Many old, large trees were examined but nothing whatever located. Then returned to the SE Corner and chained East finding Original Bearing Trees at the SE Corner of Survey 524 and at the NE Corner of Survey 19, also the Original NE Corner of Survey 524 with the Original Bearing Tree. The NE Corner of Survey 523 is now an old, large pointed Mesquite post identified by Mr. Serna as the Original location of the old corner.

Two old Marked trees were found at the N. Corner of Survey 523 and 525. No notes were found in the Surveyor's Records calling for them. At the NW Corner of Survey 525 the Original Mesquite Bearing Tree found, mkd. 'V' or 'U' with correct call. At the West corner of Surveys 525 and 526 the Bearing tree has been destroyed by clearing for a road. A $2\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe which has apparently been in place for some time is located at the fence corner and used as the corner. South, with the West line of Survey 526, the creek call checks. At the SW Corner, which is at intersection of the North Bdy. of Survey 515 and the East Bdy. of Survey 103, along a very old sendero, my re-established SW Corner of Survey 526 falls 10.0 vs. N. 39° East from an 18" Mesquite, very old, which has been very badly mutilated by others some time past. This is the only tree nearby which could answer the call and was accepted as the Original.

I then returned to my re-established North Corner of Survey 526, 524, and worked East finding the NW Corner of 160 Acre Patent of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Survey 524. Then from my corner, I ran West to the NW Corner of 526, thus establishing the NE Corner of 526 as now located, giving 524 1900.0 vs. West from its NE Corner to its NW Corner, assuming that when the 160 Acres was patented that the Surveyor had found the Original NW Corner of Survey 524. I then set the corner of 526, 524 and marked a Bearing tree as shown.

After a search of both local Abstract Offices it seems unlikely that work has been done in the area around the lost corner of 526 since 1876, which is the date of Patents of 525, 523 and NE 160 Acres of 524.
