Dear Mr Giles:

I herewith hand to you my report of the survey made by me July 29th, 30th and 31st 1943 in making Corrected Field Notes to Surveys 110, 112, 120 and 160 acres of survey No. 104 all surveys of the B.S. & F. Certificate.

I began my work at the original corner of Survey's No. 113, 115, 114 and 116 of the B.S. & F. Block, which corner is on the ground and can and has been identified for years.

I then run my line East and at 1940 varas I located the common corner of surveys No's 111, 113, 112 and 115 B.S. & F. where I had in 1915 found the original witness tree standing but since then there has been opened a County Road and in doing so the Witness tree was grubbed up, However the tree is still in existence but has been pulled out of place and to one side of the County Road, continuing my line East at 3885.2 varas I found the old witness mesquite tree marked J. that bears North  $43^{\circ}-00'$  East from corner this being the common corner of survey No's. 111, 109, 110 and 112 of the B.S. & F. Block, continuing East at 5820.0 varas I found an old mesquite post pointed but not the original yet located in the correct position as the original Post and Witness tree was both on the ground about the year 1925 when I had occasion to do some work there, the Witness tree in 1925 was dead and laying on the ground but since has been moved and there is now a field where the tree originally stood., this is the common corner of surveys No's 109, 103 104, and 110 of the B.S. & F. Block.

I then run my line along an old fence South  $11^{\circ}-42'$  East and at 1945 varas I found a pointed mesquite post however same is not the original post but located in the correct position as the old witness tree is still standing but the marks are getting very dim, some one has marked another Mesquite K that bears North  $12^{\circ}-00'$  West 4.7 varas.

I then returned to a fence post that bears South  $11^{\circ}-42'$  East 485 varas from the original Northeast corner of survey No. 110 and the Northwest corner of survey No. 104 and run around the ~~160.38~~ 160.38 acres of survey No. 104 B.S. & F. as fenced, North  $89^{\circ}-27'$  East along an old fence and at 719 varas I passed North of an old County line post 4.8 varas and at 1043.8 varas to a pointed mesquite post and fence corner.

Thence South  $00^{\circ}-55'$  East along an old fence and at 952.6 varas to a pointed mesquite post the Southeast corner of this 160.38 acre survey also a fence corner post.

Thence South  $89^{\circ}-25'$  West along fence and at 856.5 varas intersected the East line of survey No. 110, at 488.7 varas North  $11^{\circ}-42'$  West of the original Southwest corner of survey No. 104, B.S. & F. and the Southeast corner of survey No. 110, B.S. & F.

Returning to the Southeast corner of survey No. 110, Southwest corner of survey No. 104, Northwest corner of survey No. 1 H. & G. and the Northeast corner of survey No. 119 B.S. & F. I run a line along an old fence South  $89^{\circ}-34'$  West 2328 varas to a fence corner by side of which the old Pointed Post marked C lay on the ground and I found two old mesquite tree marked X very old marks, one bears North  $86^{\circ}-50'$  East 11 varas and the other bears North  $89^{\circ}00'$  West 11.3 varas. the original southwest corner of survey No. 110, the Northwest corner of survey No. 119, the Southeast corner of survey No. 112 and the Northeast corner of survey No. 120 all B.S. & F. Block

I then run a line South  $00^{\circ}-09'$  East along an old fence and at 1931.7 varas to a fence corner post and an iron pipe and described by L.M. Brumfield, Deputy County Surveyor of Duval County May 8th 1936 as the South West corner of survey No. 119, B.S. & F.

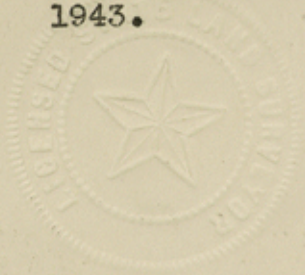

I then run a line North  $89^{\circ}-15'$  West along an old line of Post and at 1906.3 varas I located the Southwest corner of survey No.120 in or about center of the County Road from Tilden, To San Diego and claimed by Mr A.L.Dilworth a former owner of survey No.120 as being the line, and at 2088.3 varas to a point in said road and claimed by Mr A.L.Dilworth to be the original corner, <sup>Survey</sup> he stated that only a few years past he saw the old witness tree called to be marked H that bears North  $82^{\circ}-00'$  East 28 varas. this tree is evidently gone for I had Mr Dilworth to go with me to the place as he said that he could find the original witness tree but he failed to find same yet he identified about where the original corner post stood.

I then run North  $00^{\circ}-37'$  West along the said road to the place of beginning or the Northwest corner of survey No.112.
