Dear Sir:- I am herein enclosing corrected field notes to J. B. Peal's lands in Duval County, surveys-390--790-792 and 794, of which we have already forwarded you corrected field notes to 796- and 383, which he desired patented, and for which he sent you a draft on the Union State Bank of this city in blanks to fill out the charges for the same, however he advised me last week, that the Luling Oil Co., and Magnolia had already deposited to his credit in the land office sufficient money to cover the patent charges on these surveys, and if no disposition had been made of his draft to have it returned to him at Bruni, Texas., or his Atty. Cullee Mann, of this city.

I wish to ask that in the tracing sent your office of these surveys, that the east line of survey 790 be changed from 1901 vrs to 1900.5 vrs., and the east line of survey No. 792, be changed from 1908 vrs to 1912.5 vrs corrections made before corrected field notes were issued for recording in land office.
