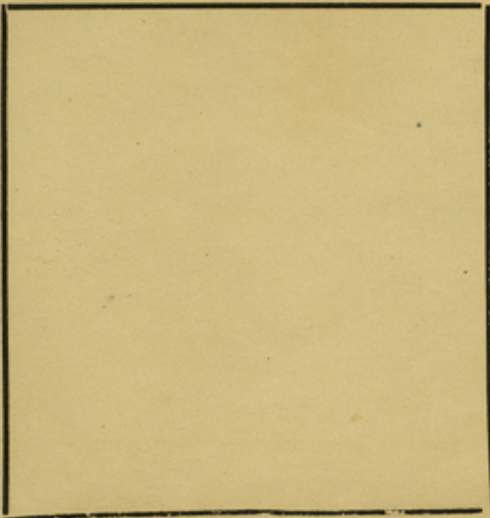

Thence N. 60° W. at 1900 ms. <sup>the</sup> pass N. cor. Sur. No. 11, Belk. 10, G. H. & S. A.  
Ry. Co. from which a L. O. 5" br. S. 63 1/4° W. 64 ms. L. O. 5" br. S. 63 3/4° W. 63 3/2 ms.  
Stump rotted of just above ground br. N. 54 1/2° E. 27 1/2 ms.  
Thence N. 60-15° W. 5475 ms. <sup>st. md.</sup> to S. cor. of Sur. No. 94, Jno. H. Gibson  
Cert. No. 304, from which a L. O. Stump 8" high, br. N. 36 ms. L. O. 10" br.  
N. 69 1/2° E. 43 ms. no mark showing.

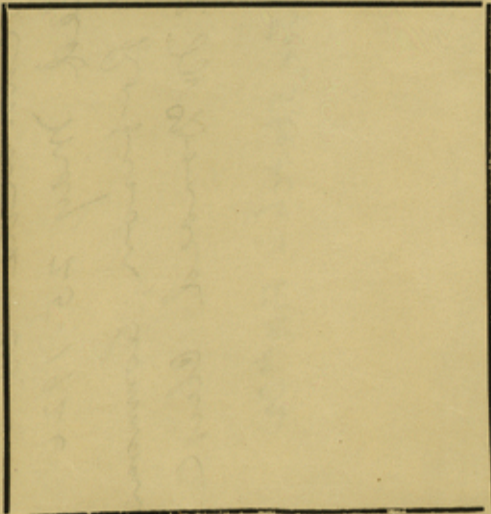
