

State of Texas I Robert M. Wyatt Surveyor of
Ellis County, Ellis County hereby Certify that
in order to correct surveys conflicting with Thomas J.
Chambers 8 League Survey, and to make other surveys bor-
dering on said Chambers West line and also on De
La Garcia's 3 League Survey, I commenced at
T. A. Chambers S.W. cor. (in Navarro Co.) as described in
the field notes of a Patented Survey, in the name
of W. A. Langhans. A Stake.

Thence N 40 $\frac{3}{4}$ W 10850 varas to a Stake
set by me for corner, (Run with 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ variation)

I then went to the N.E. cor. of
De La Garcia's 3 League Survey. I set a
Stake in the South line of Eleven Leagues Survey
in the name of Rafael Pena (and the Beginning
of the same) from which a Hackberry tree
South 1 varas, said tree is about 14 in. in diameter
and has ten hacks on the S & E sides of it.

From this corner a marked line runs S 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ E with
two variations, (marks have a very old appearance)

I Run S. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. (without variation) from said Stake
following an old line 1000. vs. at 2055 vs. enter
Prairie at 5301 vs. South Prong of Smith creek at
6100 vs. a small creek - at 10,000 vs. I set a
Stake for corner in said Rafael Pena S.E. line 100
varas. S 89 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. of A. J. Henderson's 320.12 P. Co. Survey, N.W. cor.

Thence S 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. (without variation) 10,200 varas to
a Stake on the West Bank of Walker's Creek

Thence South 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. (without variation) 1270 vs.
to a Stake from which two Elms. 10 in. hrs. S 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ E
120 vs. (said Elms. has six old hacks on the S & E sides of each
supposed to represent the S.W. cor. of the 6th League as shown
by T. A. Chambers plat of 8 Leagues) and on at the same
degree 3013. varas, in all to said T. A. Chambers N.W. cor
connecting the first line run

is such a mixed up of running
with and without variation
and the courses and distances
so different from those of these
resp. held notes that no consid-
eration can be taken of it.
