At a special meeting of the town council of Tsteta, called for the purpose of considering and determining what course of action it was necessary for the corporation to adopt in regard to the claim and survey recently made by John I Randolph county surveyor of El Paso County, of the J. J. Ascarte grant made by the legislature of the State of Texas, in July - 1858 and in which survey said county surveyor ran over and trespassed upon the lands of persons holding titles under the corporation of the town of Tsteta, and at which special meeting, there were present B. Mariani Mayor, Jose B. Garcia, Charles Kerber, James Buchanan and Julian Trijollen, being a quorum, the following resolution was introduced by Alderman Kerber

Be it remembered by the town council of the town of Tsteta that protest be made to the Hon. Commissioner of the Genl Land Office of the State of Texas, to the issuance of a patent to said Ascarte or his assignee's covering any lands of said corporation which

they hold or occupy by virtue of
the patent No 393. Vol. 19. and patent
No 220 Vol. 13. or under the Tays
survey in 1873. a copy of which sur-
vey shall be attached to this resolu-
tion also the Diffenderfer survey
made in 1853, a copy of which
shall be attached to a certified
copy of this resolution and said
resolution was seconded by Alder-
man Trifollen and the mayor
thereupon put the resolution
to the council to vote, and aldermen
Trifollen, Kerber, Buchanan and
Garcia voted in the affirmative
and none in the negative, and the
resolution was thereupon by the
mayor declared carried

It was also moved and seconded
and carried that Allen Blacker
Esq, be and he is hereby authorized
and employed to prepare said
protest and send it forward forth-
with to the commissioner of the
Genl Land office, and take
such other steps as he deems
necessary as an attorney at
law, to protect the interest

of said corporation

Whereupon the Council adjourned
