"This day came the Defendant by his Attorney, and the Plaintiff being therein called at the Court House door came not, and Plaintiffs Attorney John D. Watts being also thrice called at the Court house door, came not. Thereupon came a jury consisting of John P. Clark, and eleven other good and lawful men, duly empanelled and sworn to try the issue between the parties, who, after hearing the evidence, retire, and after due deliberation, bring into open Court the following verdict, to wit:-

"We the jury find for the Defendant."

John P. Clark, foreman.

It is therefore considered by the Court, that the ---

Defendants title be confirmed, and that the Defendants recover of the Plaintiff the premises herein sued for and described and bounded as follows; (as per Patent from the State of Texas to the Inhabitants of Ylleta, dated Feby. 17. 1858) - Situated in El Paso County, Texas, on the east bank of the Rio Grande above the town track of Ylleta. Beginning at the N. W. Corner of the town track of Ylleta on the Rio Grande - Thence up said river with its meanders to the point where the Rio Grande and Rio Viejo separates. Thence down the east bank of the Rio Viejo to the S. E. Corner of Survey No. 12 located in the name of J. H. Dugan. Thence North with the east line of said survey to where it crosses the northern line of the Geneci track. Thence east with the North line of the Geneci track, to the N. W. Corner of the Ylleta track, Thence along said line to the place of beginning. And that the Defendant be quieted and sustained in the possession of the afore described property and that he recover of the Plaintiff his costs in this behalf expended and that he have his execution therefor. It is further ordered that execution issue in favor of the officers of the Court -
