that the Hendershott survey conflicts with neither
nor any other survey known by any official means
and that the above is a true representation
of the original survey and their connection on the
ground re examined on yesterday

than represented on
the land office sketch
in running from Looney S E corner
No. 4000 across then N 30 W
20 25' 07" strikes the line of
