Sir

I have the honor
to present you with the
field work done by me at different
intervals. I commenced the work March
1st A. D. 1873. At the S. W. corner of
J. Montgomery survey, at this point I
found an Elm tree as called for in the
Field Notes of said Montgomery survey
Thence ran a line N 60° E (crossing
Pond or Cow Creek immediately)
1000 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ the S. E. corner of Montgomery
Thence continued this line N 60° E
at 1276 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ crossed a branch at 1776 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀
set a stake in the prairie for the S. E.
corner of Mr. A. Crenshaw. Thence N 30
W at 908 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ crossed a branch 1100
⁰⁰/₁₀₀ set a stake for the N E corner
of Crenshaw, but found none of the
corner trees called for by the field
notes. Thence ran a line S. 60 W
I found the N. W. corner of Montgomery
Labor. as called for in field notes
Aug. 5th A. D. 1873.

I commenced work at the point where
I suppose to be the S. E. corner of
Crenshaw. Thence N 60° E. 1243 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀

set a stake for the N.E. corner of Lewis Biscamp. at this point I did not find the trees called for in the Biscamp survey. Thence S 30 E at 740 was a branch 2230 was a Post Oak tree marked 9 bears S 76 W 150 was Thence S 60 W 532 was in prairie. Thence S. 30 East 680 was I find one of the bearing trees of the John Harvey survey an Elm bears S. 30 W 12 was marked U.

from this point I go back to the S.E. corner of L. Biscamp ran a line N 60 E 15-18 was here I examine for the bearing trees of the A. J. Miles survey but find none that I could claim for corner trees continued N 60 E at 80 was crossed a small branch in prairie at 570 was I find a Live Oak marked L and an Elm stump almost decayed that I take to be the N W corner of J. J. Shields at 720 was crossed Live Oak Creek at 15-5-8 here are some Mesquite timber but none that I could call bearing trees of Houston Greenwood survey. Then I continue this line N 60 E 326 was here I find

a Muskquit stump corresponding
with that called for in the
notes of the J. J. Shields survey
from this point - I go back to
where I suppose to be the S.E.
Corner of Mc. Greenwood ran
a line $N 30^{\circ} W 1030$ var

here I find the trees called for
in the Cottin field notes.

Then I go to the N.E. corner
of Holman survey thence S 60
W. with the line of Holman
and Miles survey. I found
this line did not close by
100. or 150 var which I will
clearly show by the accompany-
ing plat.
