I give you here a statement
 in regard to the John Wenderhot
 Survey A Survey being called for
 I began at the S W Corner of the
 J B Lockridge Survey which I
 identified by the bearing trees as
 described in the plat of said
 Survey Thence From N 30 E at
 C 3270 (the distance called for in
 the field notes) no marks of any
 line found at 3461 yards struck the
 North line of the H Cottine Survey
 Thence S 60 W at 140 yds crossed a small
 Creek and following the marked line
 continued to a point in prairie 3088 yds
 for the S W Corner Thence N 30 W 1000 yds
 the corner as described in plat could
 not be found made a corner as follows
 a stake in lot of timber from which
 a Pecan bears N 4 E 10 yds marked K and
 an ash 6 in in diameter bears N 40 E 12 yds
 Thence N 62 E 530 yds instead of 662 yds
 to the corner as described by an Elm
 marked X S 63 W 65 yds and a mesquite
 stump bears S 24 E 85 yds
