Survey made to prove the actual location and their connection with other surveys the surveys made by virtue of International N. K. scrip No. 94. for 640 acres.

The first survey of 61¹/₁₀ acres, is situated in Falls County on the waters of Brushy Creek, about twelve miles N. E. from the town of Marlin, and bounded as follows, on the North by a survey made for John Reed - on the East by the Wm. Keys or B. K. Thomas - on the South by the W. C. Swearingen - and on the West by the Gregoria Basquez 7 league grant. -

The second survey of 578⁹/₁₀ acres is situated in Falls County on the waters of Brushy Creek about twelve miles from the town of Marlin, and bounded as follows, on the North by the W. C. Swearingen - on the East by the John Chain on the South by the W. G. Wilson, and on the west by the,

Gregoria Baquez 7 league grant -
In July last I made statement for the same
purpose, but for a more satisfactory proof
I have done the following work, to wit -
Began at the South West corner of the
Wm Bennett, survey, from which an Elm
6 inches in diameter, brs. N. 38 W. 2 1/2 vs. another
brs. S. 51 1/4 W. 5 1/4 vs. these trees bear the old
corner marks. - ran from thence S. 60 W.
at 2688 vs. looked for S. W. corner of the John
H. Walker - but could find no trees marked
for the same - the character of the country
is such that I am lead to believe the
corner was made there but destroyed -
I then ran N. 30 W. at 2665 vs. found a
stake and rock. made for the S. W. corner
of the said Walker or the S. W. corner of
the upper or Northern John H. Walker could
find no marks on this line - I continued
N. 30 W. at 2688 vs. looked for the S. W. cor.
of the S. Frances, there are plum trees,
(the kind called for in the field-notes) in
the immediate neighborhood, but I could

find no marks on them. continued
N. 30 W. at 2688 vs. a point in the open
prairie - for the N. W. corner of the S. Frances
could find no bearing trees. I then
ran S. 60 W. at 1320 vs. a point in prairie
S. 30 E. 96 vs. from the S. W. cor. of the
Samuel Kaul survey -
