deposes and says -

That he has seen and knows of his own
knowledge that the South West corner of the
Josiah Hogan league on the West side of the
Brazos river in said Falls County can be
identified by the original bearing trees called
for at said corner in the original grant
being a Post Oak and a Mesquite; and
that said bearing trees are now standing
as well as several other old marked trees
along the West line of said Hogan league.

Affiant further deposes and says that he
has seen and knows of his own knowledge
that the North West corner of the Mary Prior
league, lying just north and adjoining said
Hogan league, can be identified by the
bearing tree called for in the original
field notes, the said bearing tree being a
Double Post Oak which is now standing
and which has the original marks.
