I herewith send you Plat giving actual course & distance of the Patented Survey situated in Pusher County on the Clear fork of the Brazos river. And also the Notes of Meandering of said river. which you will please examine & give me your opinion in regard to locating the corners of said Patented Survey bordering on the river.

I began my survey at the S. E. cor. of Gillespie County school land. League No. 304 also the S. W. cor. of No. 319 which is identified by its bearings beyond any doubt. Thence N. 15° W. on a variation of 9° 20' E. crossing three creeks as described in the Field Notes of said league sur. 3° 00' W. to cor. which is also identified by its bearings. course and distance also tallying

Thence on in same direction 3° 00' W. to which should be the N. E. cor. of sur. No. 305 but find no evidence of cor. Thence in same direction

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5000 ^{ms} to place for N. E. cor of sur. no 304
El Paso county school land but find no cor.
nor any evidence of cor. Thence on in same
direction 2500 ^{ms} to what would be the N. E.
cor. of sur. no. 307 and south West corner of
315 in name of Thos. A Crosby though I
do not find any evidence of corner.

Thence N. 75 E. at 3460 ^{ms} cross creek at
10000 ^{ms} I find no cor nor any evidence
of corner.

Thence N. 15 W. at 2440 ^{ms} cross main
Elm fork of Brazos river at 2800 ^{ms} I find
no evidence of cor. though I find that ac-
cording to the field notes of the Thos. A
Crosby league sur. no. 315 that I am short
in Southings 105 ^{ms} to fit the callings
on the river. Though the original cor.
can not be found nor any evidence of it
except the callings of the river.

From this point I surveyed down
the river hunting dilligently for old corners

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giving everything actual course and distance to the south East corner of sur. no. 327 in name of E. Bell. I found no evidence of old corners.

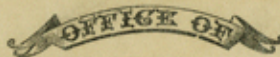
You can see from Plat that sur. no. 332 in name of N. W. Burdett will cut the river on both its E. and W. line. Also that sur. no. 326 in name of A. McKean will cut the river on its E. line. Consequently you can see that we can not give excess in Eastings to make the Burdett survey fit the callings on the river without almost obliterating the end of A. McKean sur. no. (326) lying below and on the opposite side of the river.

Seeing that the old Patented surveys on the river can not be made to fit the callings of the river according to actual course and distance as given in field notes neither can they be made to fit by giving excess in lines, will you please instruct me how to

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Locate those corners, there being no evi-
dence of old corners found.
