Dear Sir: -

While in Fisher County I cooperated  
by with Mr N. S. Bonner County Surveyor  
in the adjustment of boundaries of sur-  
veys in Block 3 H & T. C. R. R. Co. lying west  
end S.W. of El Paso Co. School Land  
League No. 307. The irregularities found  
on the ground and the manner in  
which we adjusted them is shown  
on sketch A. The discrepancy is  
the result of an error of 100 varas  
in Eastings & Westings in the Bayley  
Corrections. Survey No 117 at its S.W.  
corner calls to be 46  $\varnothing$  S 75° W and 33  
 $\varnothing$  N 15° W of old corner <sup>a st. Md.</sup> in head of a  
ravine. The other three surveys, namely;  
120. 185 & 188 call to be 33  $\varnothing$  N 15° W and  
146  $\varnothing$  S 75° W of a st Md. at old corner  
in head of a ravine. At N.W. corner  
of Sur 117. it calls to be 33  $\varnothing$  N 15° W and  
46  $\varnothing$  S 75° W of the old corner. The same  
call at this corner is made by surveys  
118. 119 & 120, all agreeing. We made  
no 117 at its S.W. corner conform to the  
calls of Nos. 120. 185 & 188 and put its  
corner 33  $\varnothing$  N 15° W and 146  $\varnothing$  S 75° W from  
the old St. Md. in head of a ravine  
The effect of this is several angles lines

From N.W. corner of No 117 to N.W. corner of  
No. 124 there is 99 <sup>00</sup> excess which we  
distributed giving each survey 1933 <sup>00</sup>  
Other irregularities found were not  
material and are shown on sketch  
A. On that sketch the lines actually  
measured are shown in red ink  
figures
