In conclusion, I must say that this is the first work ever submitted to this office, either by a County or State Surveyor, where all four corners to each section have been substantially marked.

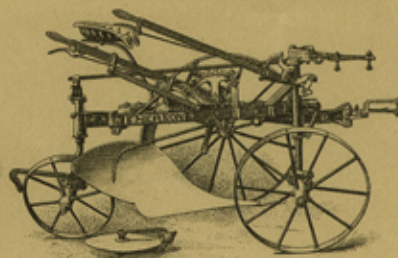
