The County Surveyor of Floyd County, Mr. J. A. Lider, was in the office last week, and submitted his report and plat of the re-survey of all the sections in Block 3 and 4 Texas and Pacific Railway Company.

I have examined same and found his work correct. The same has been approved by this office and filed, and instructed him to proceed to prepare the field notes to correspond with the work submitted.

In regard to the surveys in Block XX A 1900, for your information see enclosed blue print, representing the position of the several surveys as they are recognized by this office.

In conclusion, I must say that this is the first work ever submitted to this office, either by a County or State Surveyor, where all four corners to each section have been substantially marked.

block he never run the land
out from the river section

called for. this land is tied

sections are tied to the center


