No. 265 at a stone monument, from which a mesquite tree 9" in dia. Brs. N. 20° E. 24' vs. Another mesquite 8" in dia. Brs. S. 60° E. 51' vs. Another mesquite 8" Brs. S. 10° W. 67' vs. Thence W. 190' vs. to a stake for S.E. Cr. Sur. No. 265 to S. W. Cr. of Sur. No. 265; both of Blk. A., from which a china tree 10" in dia. Brs. S. 38° 20' W. 209.88' vs. Another do. 5" in dia. Brs. S. 37° 25' W. 207' vs. Another do. 8" in dia. Brs. S. 30° 30' W. 204.48' vs. A knob of a hill at E. end of a range of hills bears S. 7° 15' W. Thence at 11400' vs. to a stake for N.E. Cr. of Sur. No. 267 & S. W. Cr. of Sur. No. 270 both of Blk. A. From said corner a double hackberry Brs. N. 44° E. 286' vs. Another forked hackberry Brs.
