Beginning at the S. E. Cor Survey No 296 & N. W. Cor of Survey  
No 270 Block A. H. & J. C. B. B. Co from which a Hackberry  
Stump bears North 42 E 236 varas another bears N 44 E  
236 varas

\* Trees are down  
and gone

Thence North 13300<sup>00</sup> to the N. E. cor of Survey No 298 &  
the N. W. corner of 277 Block A H. & J. C. B. B. Co.

Thence West 24700 varas to the N. W. corner 518  
Block C, H. & J. C. B. B. Co.

Thence North 3800 varas & to the N. W. corner of 516  
Block A, H. & J. C. B. B. Co.

Then I went to S. E. corner Survey No 28 Block A4 H & J  
C B B Co from which a mesquite Stump about five  
feet high plainly marked bears N 68 1/2 E  
and a hackberry (dead and marked on root,) about 30 inches  
in diameter bears S 1 E 470 varas

Thence North 2003 varas a rock pile four varas E  
of line at 3965 varas a stone set in ground five varas  
west of line marked S. E. Cor Sect 9 from which Dixie  
Hill bears West and round top Mountain Cross N 30 E  
continuing North 17901 varas in all to a point 840 varas  
East of the N. W. corner of Survey No 516<sup>B1 1/2</sup> H & J. C. B. B. Co  
Then I went to the N. W. corner of Survey No 516 Block A  
H. & J. C. B. B. Co and ran West 3800 varas and established  
a corner for the S. E. corner of Survey No 36 Block A
