I wisher of ^{ll} of John Henry calling
for the Survey of 640. acres of Public
Domain" Sent fill requesting Survey of
vacant lands in this Fort-Bent County
on the N-E side of the Brazos River
& on the waters of Buffalo Bayou
I her sent you sketch made from
actual field notes in this Office of
the Original Surveys of that portion
of this (Fort-Bent) County showing actual
measures made by me on the ground
from June 1st to July 10th 1888. -
of all of the several Surveys which
this location might affect

(Also measures between the original titled
League Surveys on the Brazos River and early locations
on Buffalo Bayou which are all well marked and
long established and well known to me by previous
Survey) With the following results
1st I began at the South corner of Thomas
Habermaker 1/2 League Survey on Buffalo
Bayou, which has been known & kept marked
since its location and I find by actual
Survey of same which I have previously
made that it is correctly established,
from this point I measured S-45° E-
438. yards for the East Corner of L.A.
Patillo No 3 - a. 640. - acre Survey, where
I found a Bois-De-Are post - Thence

1 I measured S-45° W- following the line
2 dividing said No 3- from its alternate
3 No 4 (State School) 1900. across to the South
4 corner of said 3 & W. corner of said 4-
5 where I found a Bois-de-Are. post -
6 Thence I measured S° on the West
7 line of 288. across for its S-W. corner
8 in the North line of E.P. Whitehead
9 1/4 League - but did not intersect said
10 1/4 League - until I had measured the
11 distance of 704 1/2 varas, and this
12 point of intersection on said Whitehead
13 N. line I found by actual measure
14 to be 1734. varas from its N-E. corner
15 and 1815. varas from its N-W. corner
16 2^d I returned to the S. corner of Thos Habermok
17 and measured N-45° W. following his
18 S-W. line 1461. varas to the North corner
19 of L.A. Patillo No 3- Thence S° 283. N
20 into said Patillo Survey to a point on a
21 projected line with the Stephen Habermok
22 1/4 League Survey S-W. line - Thence N-45°
23 W- 2274. said S. Habermok South corner and
24 at 4774 varas his West corner & Thomas
25 Robinson 160th Homestead Survey East corner
26 "all of which corners I found well marked
27 Thence W° through said Robinson 160th Survey
28 1344 varas & set a post for his W. corner
29 Thence I measured S° 7095. varas and
30 intersected the N. line of John Foster 2 1/2
31 League Survey (a well marked line) 2805.
32 varas by actual measure W° from the N-E
33 corner of W^m Andrew's League Survey
34 3^d I returned to the W. corner of Thos Robinson
160th Survey and measured W° 10622. varas

To intersect the East line of Nathan
Brookshire one League Survey.

4^E I returned to the East corner of No-3-
L.A. Patillo and I surveyed out its lines
according to its original field note
calls of this Office with the following
results -

The 2^d call or S.E. line calls S-45° W.
1687.60 acres to a stake in the N. line of
James Perry Labor - which I found by
actual course and distance (it being all private)
does not intersect said Labor line at
all; But at 1538.5 acres I intersected
the East line of the E. P. Whitehead
1/4 League 244.00 acres N. from said
Labor N-E corner and at 1687.60 acres
its call I invade said 1/4 League
158.00 acres -

Its 3^d call is N° 376.00 acres to N-W.
corner of Perry Labor which invades said
1/4 Leo- 488.00 acres;

Its 4th call is N° 1035.00 - " following
this call I pass out of Whitehead
N. line at 628.00 acres at a point
N° 488.00 acres from its N-E corner
all of which is shown on sketch in
Red lines; This makes a shortage of
63.00 acres in amt required in No-4-
53.1/3 acres of which is in conflict with
Whitehead Survey; But leaves a
vacancy of 123.75 acres S-E of said
No 4 of which its quantity can be obtained
by correction. (Subject to order of your Office)

I next surveyed out Patillo No 3-Scrip
No 1854, and I & G-N. R-R Co Sur No-1 -

5 I next commenced at the W. corner
6 of No-1- I & G. N. R-R Co Surveyed by Scrip
7 No-3750. - "Said No. 1 - taking place of
8 Survey No-7 - Scrip No 1610 - floated or abandoned
9 This being the beginning corner of No 8 -
10 Brooks & Burlison Scrip No 221 - a 640. ^B
11 Survey - and Surveyed out - 9 - with the
12 following results - 1st call in Original
13 notes is S-45° E - at 2877. varas intersect
14 the W. line of E. P. Whitehead Survey
15 2^d S° 23. ^W to N-E corner of W^m Burlison
16 3^d N° 2325. ^W 4th call N-45° W- 1343. ^W
17 5th N-45° E- 1660. ^W to Beginning

18 The 1st line of this Survey did not
19 touch Whitehead Survey at all; But
20 at 3076. ^W I intersected W^m Burlison
21 League 384. ¹/₂ varas W° from its N-E-
22 corner —

23 Hence from these results obtained on
24 the ground by actual Survey I located
25 a Vacancy of 882. ¹/₂ acres as shown
26 on accompanying Sketch enclosed in
27 Burlison's and described as

28 Beginning at a Bois-de-Arc post set in
29 the South corner of L. A. Patillo No 3 -
30 and the W. corner of No-4 - its alternate
31 from which a Post-Oak tree 30. inches
32 in diameter marked ^{L. A. P.} No 3 Bears N 77. ¹/₂
33 W- 282. ⁴/₅ varas and a Post-Oak tree
