Dear Sir:

I have surveyed the east part of Labor No. 12, League No. 284, Schleicher County School Land in Gaines County for Mr. Trice E. Lee and in addition to the fieldnotes, I wish to add the following information I have acquired in surveying in this vicinity during the last forty years.

In about the year 1900, Mr. W.D.Twicheil, a State Surveyor, was employed to survey some of the main bodies of the Public Domain which was then turned over to the Public School Fund.

In Surveying Block C 30 in the vicinity of Cedar Lake, he identified the original northwest corner of League No. 284, which is known as the "Anderson Corner" also as "The Anderson Wells Corner".

Then to locate Block A 19 in the southeast part of Gaines County he ran southward along league lines and marking corners to the southwest corner of League No. 288.


His corners have since been used in all subdivision work in the School Leagues in this vicinity.

In April 1908 Surveyor W.L.Saye subdivided this and other Leagues of the Schleicher County School Land, conforming with the Twicheil lines. Fences and improvements have been constructed on his lines and corners, which are still easily found.

Because of the conflict between School Leagues and Block M, the owners of Leagues 282 and 284 agreed to divide the area available between these leagues, equally and employed R.T.Bucy and Robert E. Estes, Licensed Land Surveyors to make such a survey. They conformed with the Twicheil survey along the west and north lines of League No. 284 but made the east line of League No. 284, further west than the original would have been but did not change the subdivision lines.

This resulted in an adjustment of the ownership of the east row of Leagues in League No. 284, numbered 21 to 25.
