Sir!

In conformity with an application made to me by Guy M. Bryan on the 22d of May 1866, to ascertain & determine the Southern Boundary Line of the St. F. Austin Survey at Dollar Point, County of Galveston; and after having given written notice to L. M. Hitchcock and E. P. Morgan, parties interested in the land adjoining said St. F. Austin Survey, and in accordance with a transcript of the Mexican title to St. F. Austin for said tract of land, duly authenticated by the Commissioner of the Land Office, viz:

The three Lagoons are situated on the West Margin of Galveston Bay and South of the Bar, called Redfish Bar and shall have as Boundaries the Bay of Galveston in the East; the Pass entering Dickinsons Bayou and which separates Davis Point from Dollar Point on the North; a Lake on the West; and lands subject to overflow on the South;

I proceeded on the ground to determine the lower Boundary of said Survey and found, after careful examination, the northernmost of the three Bayou's emptying into Moses or Dollar Lake, and designated on the plat as No 1, running through a flat, with well defined

Banks on either side, subject to overflow, to be the true Boundary, as per title.

I also established a Cedar Post marked A on its North side, at the eastern Terminus of said Northern Bayou and near the shore of Galveston Bay, where its connection with said Bayou is closed up by a low Shell Bank, but subject to overflow from the Bay, as the South East Corner of this Survey, distant from the extreme Northern Point opposite Davis Point, four thousand five hundred & sixty varas.
