

The above sketch shows the position of Duffy's Reath with surveys surrounding as I found them by actual survey on the ground (See my statement filed in Ld office by hands J.T. Lofton -)

The connection I have made with Block 8. At D.G.W.  
R.R. Co. is in accordance with a survey made by W.E. Kaye  
and Shephard 1887.

The red lines show position of the surveys as they would be on the ground if Mr W.C. Knight was correct in his location of the N.E. corner of 1111 T.T. from Duffy's peak, but then the length of the North line of 1111 would be only 1630 varas, and to reach the N.W. corner - 1111 - as established on the ground and which I found as indicated on this sketch, the course would be  $183\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  N. 1630 E. S. However some difference might be made by his having taken a point farther north than I did at Duffy's peak - I undoubtedly found the monuments as made by Mr Hays, and the N.E. corners of surveys 1110 - 1109, 1111, T.T. and the monument 2015 E of NE 1111, as indicated are all in a direct line.
