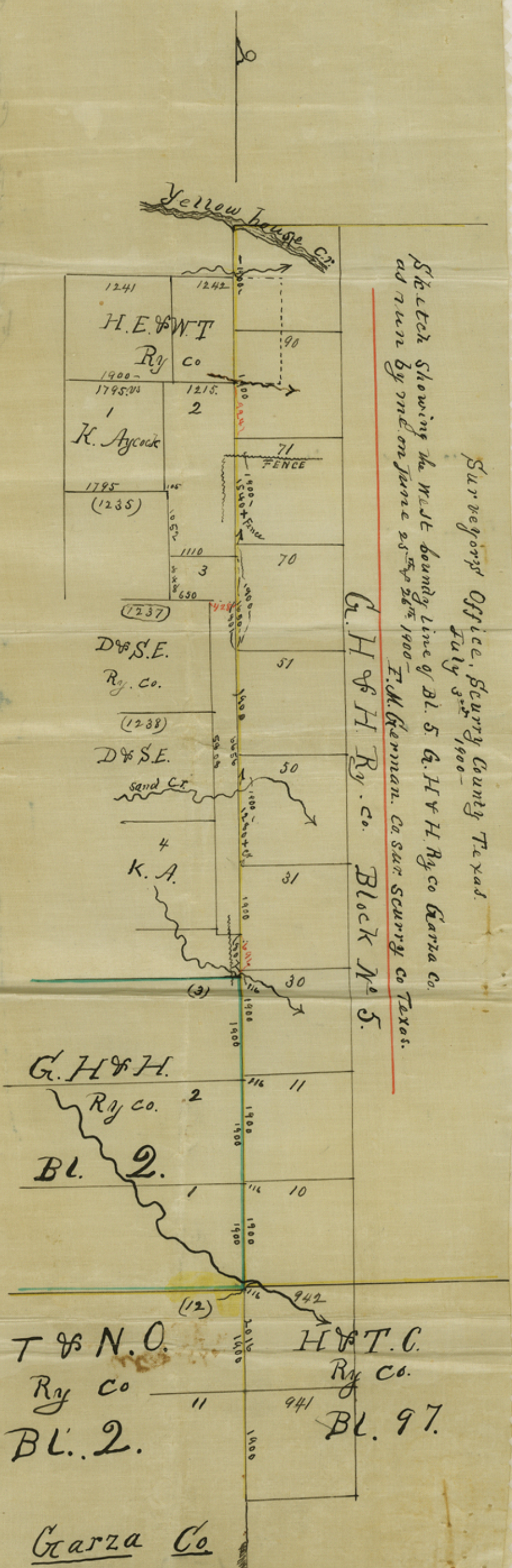

State of Texas
County of Scurry $\frac{2}{3}$ Field notes of a survey of the
East boundary line Block No 2. and West boundary
of Block No-5 Galveston, Houston and Henderson
Railroad Company. Situated in Garza County
Texas.

I began at the North West corner of Survey
No. 941. Block 97. A & T. Ry. Co. a rock
set in the ground marked N.W. 941-97-
from which a mes. 5" in dia bears $N 9\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W -$
100 varas. (rock and mes still standing) This
corner was established by Geo. Spiller State
Survey A.D. 1887. I then ran North
(Vernier set at $9^{\circ} - 15' E$) at $1900\frac{9}{10}$ varas I
set a stone in ground marked N.E. - 12 from
which a stone set in the ground marked N.E. 12
bears $N 21^{\circ} E 64$ varas. and stone mound bears $N 34^{\circ} W$
 $214\frac{1}{2}$ varas. I then ran North at 116 varas.
a stake in small br for the N.W. corner of
Survey No. 942. Block 97. A & T. Ry. Co.
being also for the S.W. corner of Sur. No. 10
Block 5. A. & T. Ry. Co. Continued
North at 226 varas. x Cooper Creek. (C.S.E.)
at $5702\frac{4}{10}$ varas. a stone mound for
the N.E. corner of Block No. 2. G. A. & H.
Ry. Co. from which a mulberry in a
clump of mulberries standing on the south
bluff bank of a creek. bears $N 20\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 122$
varas. and a hackberry bears $N 19\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 121\frac{1}{2}$
varas.

Cont'd North at 116 varas a Stone mound
for the N.W. Corner of Survey No. 30. Block 5.
G. H. & H. R.R. Co. from which a Stone mound
bears N 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W 117 varas.

Thence North at 691 varas. pass the S.E.
Corner of Survey No. 3. Block 5. K. Aycock.
from which a stone mound on a rocky hill bears
South 62 varas. from which a gate in fence
bears ~~N~~ 69° W 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas. a conical mound
in Valley bears N 39° E. Cont'd

North at 1900 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas. the N.W. corner
of Survey No. 31. Block No. 5. G. H. & H. a
Stone mound bears N 45° W 112 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas.

Thence North at 1780 varas x Sand Creek
(C.R.E) at 1840 vs top of a hill at 1900 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas.
N.W. Cor of Survey 50 Bl. 5 G. H. & H. R.R. Co.

Thence North at 1900 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas. the
N.W. Corner of Survey No. 51. said Blk. 5.
a Stone mound bears N 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W 84 varas.

Thence North on West line of Sur
No. 70. at 560 varas. top of a red sand
hill at 801. Varas. I made connection with
the N.E. corner 1237. D & S.E. R.R. Co.,
Survey ^{which} bears West 428 varas. (The N.E. cor.
of 1237. D & S.E. Ry Co is a large stone mound
from which a large flat rock mtd x bears
N 17° E.) Cont'd North on the West line of 70.
at 1650 varas. pass the N.E. Corner of survey
No. 3. Blk 5. K. Aycock. a Stone mound

from which a clump of hickberys one mile
br $N 20^{\circ} E 114 \frac{1}{4}$ vs. a mes 4" in dia br $S 50^{\circ} E 40 \frac{1}{2}$
vs. Cont'd North at 1900 ft vs. the N.W. cor
of 70.

Thence North at 1540 x a fence at 1900 ft vs
the N.W. cor of 71.

Thence North at 924 vs. the N.E. cor
of sur no. 2, K Aylock. Near the South bank
of a deep draw at 950 vs x said draw at
1900 ft vs. the N.W. corner of sur no. 90. on
the East slope of a hill a stone md br.
 $N 4 \frac{1}{2} W - 86 \frac{1}{4}$ varas.

Thence North at 800 vs x a creek at
1900 ft vs. a ~~stone~~ vault box in channel of
yellow house creek. a mes br $S 1^{\circ} W 65$ vs another
 $S 1^{\circ} W 66 \frac{1}{4}$ varas., a large rock on a rocky point
North of creek br $N 11 \frac{1}{2} E$ a rock on point of md
on South bank br $N 65^{\circ} W$ about 700 vs.
