Hon Chas Rogau Comr,

Dear Sir. Enclosed I have  
you sketch of work done by me. in Garza co.  
about 12 miles N 10° W Center County -

The surveys bordered by grantint. marked 1-2-3-  
4 & 5. Block "S" were made in accordance with certain  
applications under the provisions of the act of 1900-  
providing for surveying unsurveyed lands &c -

The field notes of which will shortly be presented  
in your office for filing -

You will observe that I have made the South  
boundary lines of surveys 2-3 & 4- of this Block S.  
52 varas North of a line running East West. over  
the center of Duffys peak. I did so from the fact  
that Jasper Hays. who I am <sup>credibly</sup> informed made the  
survey by which all these old surveys were located -  
and he makes the distance from the North boundary  
of surveys 1111-1109- & 1110- T. T. R.R. Co just 3 miles North  
from Duffys peak. and I made the distance from  
the center of Duffys peak. 3 miles & 52 varas -

A line East & West 52 rows farther North would pass over the North end of same and would fulfill the Calls. of the Survey. Calling for Druff's Peak -

I made a <sup>written</sup> statement of the runs I made and what I found on the ground. with sources of data I had, and delivered the same to Mr J. T. Lofton. who will hand them to you to file

He is interested in lands in conflict with surveys effected by the locality of these surveys. I don't presume to attempt to change the position of any of the surveys. and can only give you the facts.

The Calls are so conflicting and divergent that I am at a loss. to properly locate the unsurveyed land - and present this sketch ~~such facts and if you are not correct probably~~ from data in your office you may inform <sup>me</sup> how to correct.

I wish to call your attention to field notes Sur. vol. 418 A. Bk 5, which will be presented to be filed in name J. B. Cotton. He insisted upon having survey made claiming that if certain calls were adhered to in surveys adjoining. there would be vacancy - I told him I did not think it could be there -
