Snyder Texas July 10th 1900 -

Statement of a retracement Survey made by
~~me~~ J. M. German, Co Surveyor of Dewey County,
of the lines in the vicinity of Duffys Peak.

Duffys Peak is situated in Garza County,
on the East bank of the Salt fork of the Brazos
river about 12 miles N 15° W from the center of
said county and is a rocky hill or knoll.
Some 50 or 60 feet high - 700 or 800 feet in length
North & South and 300 or 400 feet in width -
No other prominence near.

I began near the center of top of same and
ran East (Var set on Vernier 10°-30' E) and at
940 varas set stake. here I found a few flat stones
lying on ground. 7 1/2 varas North and 8 varas West
of this point. no marks on them - no other rocks in
the vicinity. in a mesquite flat.

I then ran North from the stake ^{last set.} 5700 varas -
(I had the field book of Jasper Hays - giving his
notes of a run from the N.E. corner of Survey
142 - Block 2 of G. N. McCoy Sur. to this point. and
for 3 miles West and also connecting this point with
Duffys Peak. which he made 3 miles S + 940 West -
also he calls for Large Stone mound on North side
of hill. one mile East of this ^{point} - 180 varas.
South of a branch. made Sept 25th 1877 -

I ran East ~~440~~ ^{and} at 1950 varas. 70 varas North
I found the large Stone mound as described -

I then returned to last station and moved stake
North 70 varas and ran West ^{on random line -} (Var 10-30' E)
at 810 varas x Salt fork. at 2080 varas.
fell 34 varas North of a Stone set in the ground

marked \times a flat stone lying on grd near a stony point $\text{N}4^{\circ}\text{E } 259\frac{1}{2}$ varas.

I then returned to the 1st station ^{1 mile} East and moved the stake 17 N. S. and 65 varas west and at this point Two Cotton wood trees standing near the north end of a large sand hill - one standing the other lying on grd roots still in grd - bear $\text{S}48^{\circ}\text{W}$ 640 varas distant ^{in compass} $\text{S}65^{\circ}\text{W}$. I could not find Cotton wood. I presume it has washed away the river here runs through level sandy bottom - and is some 40 or 50 varas wide.

I adopted this point as the N. E. cor of 1111 - F. J. R. R. sur cert. 296. from the fact that it is equidistant from each of the two monuments - made by Mr. Hays as I understand ^{he} was the locator of these surveys. making the north line of 1111 - 2015 - varas - and 2015 varas west of the monument East and the two Cottonwoods so nicely filling the conditions of the call $\text{S}48^{\circ}\text{W}$ - front - this point. I also found a stone set in grd marked $\text{S}E$ 1101 - ^{or} $\text{S}54^{\circ}\text{W}$ 116 varas distant - The length of the line from the point 940 East of Duffys peak. to this point is 5752 varas; In the running of this line I observed considerable local atmospheric or electrical disturbance of the needle I ran transit lines -

I then went to stone set in grd at N. W. corner of 1111 F. J. R. R. sur. and ran West - (var 11°E) and at 1900 varas found old stone pile of round stones - only missing it a few varas.

Thence South 3800 varas found old

Stone mound for S.E. cor 1115 Tyler Tap ^{cut 248-}

Thence East 115 varas. I made a stone md -
Thence South at 1952 varas. to a point
due West of Duffys Peak. found small stone
md a little distance East. and one ^{about} ~~some~~ 100 varas
West.

Thence East at 1600 varas a stone md,
about 75 varas North - at 1900 - a point
100 varas West of a branch searched for
stone md found none. this point is in a
low branch bottom densely set with grass
and weeds. Subject to overflow - probably
covered by wash dirt or washed away.

Cont'd East at 965 varas to place
of beg on top of Duffys Peak.

I then Beg at the point East of
Duffys Peak 940 varas. and ran
East. at 1800 varas pass 2 varas South
of a stone set in 2^d MK'd X. 1900
rs. stake. Cont'd East at 3800 varas
stake - at 5700 varas stake at 7500 a
stake. 495 varas South of a stake marked
N.W. cor. 43. Set by W. E. Kaye a surveyor
from Ft. Worth. in a run made by him
Nov^r 28 - 1899 - ^{North} from a Stone Mound for
the N.W. corner of sur. No. 19, Block 8.
A V.G. N. claimed by him to have been set
or established by a run from an old Stone
Corner found on White river. by a survey
made by him and Mr Shepherd. 1887 -
15 miles West of the S.E. corner of said
Section 19 Block 2. at which place they

Show on their map to have found an old stone
end - 3' high 3' wide -

There is so great a discrepancy in these surveys
made by Kaye & Shepherd. and H. C. Knight
and Mr Hays. ~~such~~ no two agreeing -
that I am not able to determine which
is correct as to the Locality of the West
and South lines of Block 8 449.
