

Field-Notes of survey in Garza County, Texas, made Nov: 25th 1900.

Beginning at old Stone mound on hill, found and identified as the original corner, by calls for "Black Bottle" and notes therein very dim in Sept: 1888, as called for in field-notes and Patent of G. W. T. & P. R. R. Co. Sec. East. cor. of section No. 1225 and N. E. Cor. of E. H. & Red. River. R. R. Co. section No. 1225.

Thence south 1900 vrs. a stake with loose prairie boulders piled around for S, E. Cor. of said 1225.

Thence South, 1092 vrs. Stake driven in Prairie for the N. W. Cor. of Tyler Tap R. R. Co. sec. No. 1236.

Thence East 1250 vrs. Stone set for S. W. Cor. of Tyler Tap R. R. Co. Sec. No. 1235.

Thence East 650 vrs. Stone set for N. E. Cor. of Tyler Tap R. R. Co. Sec. No. 1236 and N, W. Cor. of D. & S. E. R. R. Co. Sec. No. 1237.

Thence East 1250 vrs. Stone set for the S. E. Cor. of said Tyler Tap R. R. Co. Sec. No. 1235, marked K X. and other stones piled around.

Thence East at 650 vrs. a stake in Stone mound, for the N, E. Cor. of D. & S. E. R. R. Co. Sec. No. 1237.

Thence East at 390 vrs. the west line of G. H. & H. R. R. Co. Block No. 5 as made by C. G. Woodbridge, and 739 vrs. North of the S. W. Cor. of G. H. & H. R. R. Co. Sec. No. 70 as made by said Woolbridge
