Spur Tex Feb 27-1935

Mr A. L. Harris Lubbock Tex

Dear Sir: -

Mr C. B. Jones who has charge of the lands  
owned by S. M. Swanson & Son & others,  
received a list of acreage in each section,  
thru which County line between Kent &  
Garza runs across the old Spur Ranch  
territory. Mr C. M. Voss sent Mr Jones a  
list. It seems the Land Office at Austin  
changed the acreage in some sections  
from your list. Your list is correct and  
conforms to the resurvey made by me  
in 1908 & 1910. The land office seems to  
have taken the area of sections figured  
from Geo. Spiller's work of 1900. Spiller's  
work was needle work - and there is local  
attractions in that locality. Spiller's claiming  
was not good. I recognized all of Spiller's  
corners. The North line of Section 56  
block 2 N & G. R. RR line is short. Spiller  
calls it 2056 varas. On the ground I  
found it 1958<sup>±</sup> varas - both corners were well  
identified. This discrepancy makes the area  
of 56- 57 & 72 shorter or less than the  
counter 24097

Spiller map. would make it  
Sec. 56 - was patented to A. J. McLain  
making N & S. lines 2056 - area ~~#~~ 695<sup>6</sup> as  
The sec. is short on the ground.

I think the areas you made out should  
be adhered to as they are correct.  
I wish you would write me about  
this matter. I thought perhaps. you  
had had some correspondence with  
Land on this. Glad you ran the  
county lines - Dickens & Crosby - should  
get you to run the line between them.
