REFERRED TO MAP

With reference to your letter of December 8th regarding the survey of section #10, Block #33, Township #3 South, Glasscock County, Texas, I beg to advise that, in the light of information contained in the sketch transmitted therewith, I have corrected the above survey and am enclosing herewith corrected Field Notes and Plat of same for your approval and recording.

The witness tie for the common corner of sections #3-#4-#45-#46 was found and checked, and as a result the old rock mound at this point is definitely identified as the original common corner of these sections. The Eastern end of this Township line, where it joins the West boundary of section #217, Block #29, W. & N. W. R. R. survey, is also definitely established by these notes. As a result, the North boundary of this Township is moved North 15.5 Varas at the center of the Block, giving it an angle, at this common corner, of one degree and twenty six minutes. The Eastern end of this line, continued Eastward to and intersection with a Northward projection of the East boundary of this Block, falls at a point exactly 5700 Varas N. 14-48' W. from the N. E. corner of section #24. This not only eliminates all excess, but reduces the acreage in sections #3-#4-#10-#11-#14-#15 to 634.4 acres each.

In making this adjustment I surveyed the West Block line from the N. W. Block corner South to the N. E. corner of section #24, Block #34-3-South, as established by W. F. Kellis, Licensed Land Surveyor, in 1926. The total length of this line, 5731.5 Varas, was applied to West boundary of sections #3-#10-#15, thus making the South boundary of sections #16-#17-#18 parallel with the North boundary of sections #4-#5-#6. However, in the interests uniformity, the West boundary of section #10 was made one third of 5731.5, or 1910.5 Varas, and the N. W. and S. W. section corners established as indicated on the Plat. The lengths of the other section boundaries were then determined proportionally and all corners tied by actual survey to the N. E. corner of section #24, The N. W. corner of section #3, and the N. W. and N. E. Block corners. The East and West boundaries of section #10 were made parallel to the East boundary of the Block, and all magnetic bearings are based upon that given by the T. Seay survey for the North boundary of sections #4-#5-#6. Solid lines, on the Plat, indicate lines actually surveyed.

I trust that this adjustment will be found satisfactory, and wish to express my sincere thanks for your generous cooperation in sending me the Field Note sketch, returned herewith, as requested.

In sending me the Field Note sketch, returned herewith, as requested, I trust that this adjustment will be found satisfactory, and

that given by the T. G. survey for the North boundary of sections 44-48-40. Solid lines, on the plat, indicate lines actually surveyed. boundary of the block, and all magnetic bearings are based upon West boundaries of section 410 were made parallel to the East of section 40, and the N. W. and N. E. Block corners. The East and actual survey to the N. E. corner of section 434, the N. W. corner as indicated on the plat. The lengths of the other section boundaries of section 410 were made one third of 2731.5, the West boundary of section 410 was made one third of 2731.5, the South boundary of sections 48-49-40. However, in the interests uniformity was applied to West boundaries of sections 48-49-40 parallel with the North boundary of section 410. The total length of this line, 2731.5 acres, Block 434-5-South, as established by W. F. Kellett, licensed land the N. W. Block corner South to the N. E. corner of section 434. In making this adjustment I surveyed the West Block line from excess, but reduced the acreage in sections 43-44-410-411-412-413 the N. E. corner of section 434. This not only eliminates all this Block, falls at a point exactly 2700 Acres N. 14-48, W. from intersection with a Northward projection of the East boundary of minutes.
