Dear Sir - Having been asked by L. J. Clark & Son, whose address is Water Valley Texas, to make a survey and corrected field notes of surveys 8, 18 & 20 in Block 32 Township 4 South and Survey 12 Block 33, T-4S. of T & P. R. R. Co. surveys in Glasscock Co, I wish to state that in 1926, I made a survey of the North portion of said Blk, 33, T. 4S -

I will not go into details as to all the work I did, but will refer you to the map, of this date, accompanying this report, which shows on map the original corners found on the ground at that time.

I found all original corners on N. line of Township 4 Block ³² ~~33~~ from the N.W. corner of 3 to N.W. corner of 6, except the middle corner in N. line of 5, also all original corners in W. line said Township Blk. 32 from N.W. corner of 6 to middle corner in W. line of 19, except in mid. of W. line of 7 I found no corner or bearings; The present S.E. corner 12 Blk 33 and N.E. cor. 18 Blk 32 was marked with a set stone mkd "S.E. 12" in 1926 and still remains. This corner while originally called for earth md, I am of the impression it occupies the proper position, being 953 vts N 13 W from the middle corner in ^{w. line} 18; at which point the original bearing tree, standing.

I found the variation to fit these lines in 1926 to be 13° 06' E at this date 13° 10' E Between ^{original} corners found on the ground on N. & W. side of this Block

I wish to state that in 1902 a meander survey of the north portion
of said Block 32-T-12

I found all original corners on section of township 4 south from the
corner of a 1/2 section of a survey of the north portion in 1902
all corners in a line of 1/2 section in north of line of a found in corner
or bearings; the present section is 12 1/2 and 12 1/2
was marked with a bit stone mark 2 1/2 in 1902 and still remains
the corner which originally called for with one of the original
recorder the proper position being 12 1/2 from the north corner

I found, what I believed to be, original corners on E. line of this Block 32, the course of said E. line (using same var.) is N13 1/2 W which corners appear to have been made by the Surveyor, locating Block 31 -

The corners on N. end of E. line of the Block are further North than the corners on W. line of the Block, for instance, to run a line N 77 E. from the original S.W. corner of 15 to the E. line of the Block will strike a point about 100 or S 13 1/2 E. from the S.E. cor. 13.

Some Surveyors, especially Mr Kellis, has been locating interior corners on this Block, from by running S 77 W. from corners on E. line of the Block, which has a tendency to shorten all surveys in the north portion of the Block.

In my work of this month, going over the N. & W. line of this Blk (32) I found the corners same as in 1926, and finding nothing in the south, west and north lines that would prevent, in my judgment, all surveys in the west half of the Block from holding their full amount, I have prepared the corrected field notes of the surveys, mentioned, in keeping with the map here with presented - While the fences, as shown on map, are not in keeping with my construction, I see no reason why the school sections are not entitled to full amounts.
