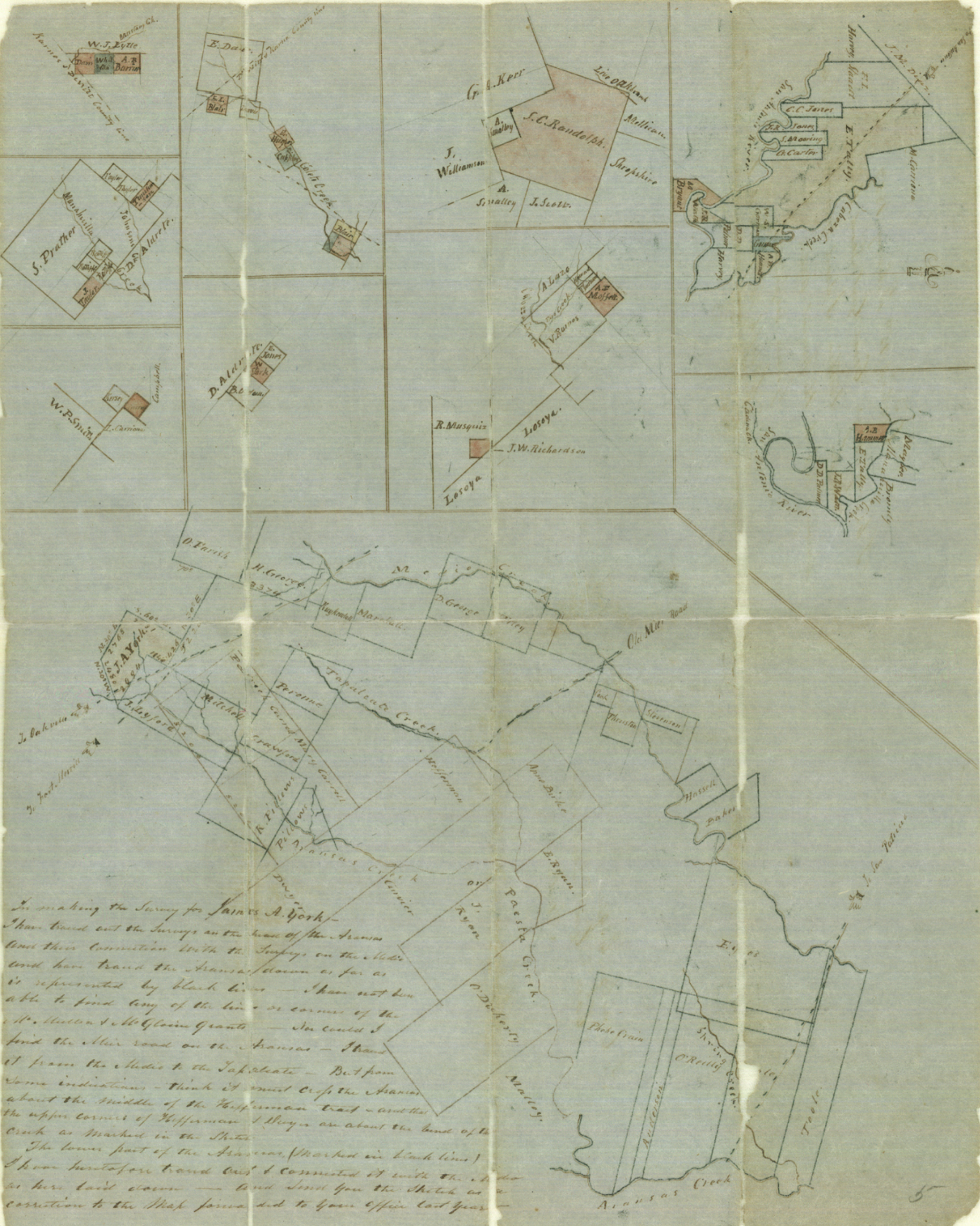

In making the Survey for James A. York -
 I have traced out the Surveys on the head of the Arkansas
 and their connection with the Surveys on the Middle
 and have traced the Arkansas down as far as
 is represented by black lines - I have not been
 able to find any of the lines or corners of the
 H. Mullens & McGloin Grants - nor could I
 find the Mill road on the Arkansas - I trace
 it from the Middle to the Tapaluate - But from
 some indications - think it must cross the Arkansas
 about the middle of the Hoffmann tract - and that
 the upper corner of Hoffmann & Boyer is about the bend of the
 Creek as marked in the Sketch.
 The lower part of the Arkansas, (marked in black lines)
 I have heretofore traced out & connected it with the Middle
 as here laid down - and send you the Sketch as a
 correction to the Map forwarded to your office last year -
