

Re-survey of the tract of land purporting to be
a League of land formerly granted to Norberto
Galán.

Situated in the County of Galán on the
South side of the San Antonio river, and
opposite to the mouth of the Manahúlla Creek.

Beginning at a point on the South bank
of the said river, shown to me as the N. W. corner
of the Donna Buentilla tract, a Stake, whose
S. 87° W. 10 Varas bears a Box Elder 16 inches Mk^d—
L. 1849 & a Box Elder 12 inches Mk^d W, bears S. 50° E,
12 Varas and S. 22° W. 9 Varas, bears a Pecan 40
inches Mk^d H, Thence Meandered the river upwards,
to wit N. 25° W. 2010 Varas, N. 36° W. 690, N. 74° W. 320,
West 35, S. 50° W. 105 Varas, opposite the mouth of
the Manahúlla, South 37° W. 990 Varas, S. 31° W. 550.
Varas to a Pecan 10 inches Mk^d D, whose S. 33° W. 3
Varas, bears a Sycamore 24 inches Mk^d A, & S. 24° W.
4 Varas, bears a Sycamore 8 inches Mk^d B. Thence
South 10847 Varas, a Stake in the prairie;— Thence
East 2500 Varas, a Stake in the prairie;— Thence
North 9700 Varas (being the first line described in
the Original Survey) to the point of beginning,
C. P. Miles & J. B. Harsh, Chain Carriers.

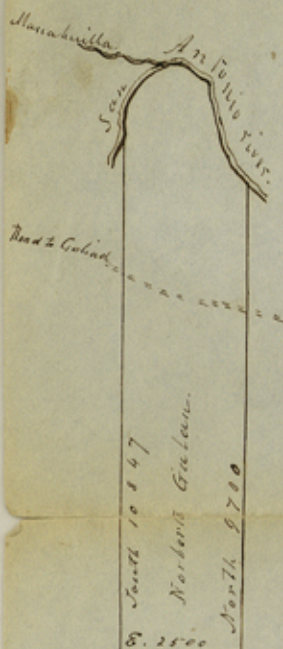
