the time thinking of the subsequent *pro* bill Statute —

Captⁿ Manry to forward to you from Mysore District
upon which I wish to obtain Patents — and therefore
wish to let my Manry remain in your Office until
I shall have paid all the fees connected with his Survey

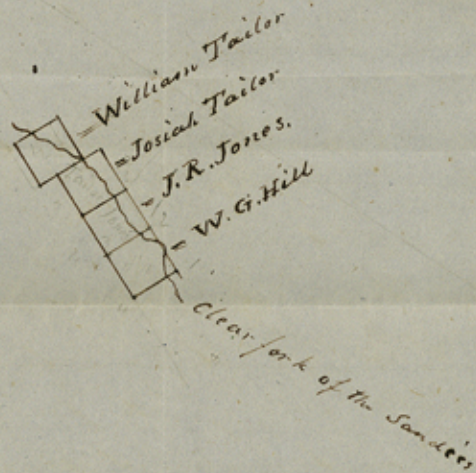

The four labor of Tailor, Tailor Jones & Hill - purport to have been surveyed on the "Clear fork of the Sandies" - by S. Addison White Deputy Surveyor - on the 2nd of June 1838 - The land appears to lie entirely outside of Goliad District and I cannot find any connection of this batch of survey with any other.

The Labor of Manuel Martinez calls for beginning "on the North East corner of a survey made for the said George Sutherland Esquire of Juan N. Seguin" - thence S. 41° E - then N. 49° E. &c. This survey not having been plotted on the old map I was ignorant of its existence, until you called my attention to it - the same land has been located and surveyed on Certificates of W. C. Howard and A. S. Thurmond - on behalf of Hannis M. Staff - in March 1855 & the same reported to your office. The labor of M. Martinez shows several other tracts originally located by George Sutherland in that vicinity have fallen vacant & been surveyed on new locations - Has not this labor, also failed?
